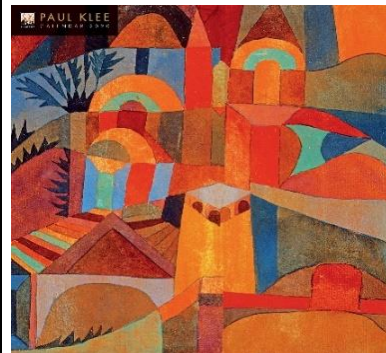

Dear Parents and Carers,

I hope you had an enjoyable and relaxing Christmas break. I would like to begin by saying thank you to you all for your wonderful work that you have been submitting on Google Classrooms. Please note that the suggested timings for each task are as follows:

1. Reading: 15 minutes daily.
2. Phonics: 20-30 minutes.
3. Writing: 45 minutes – 1 hour.
4. Maths: 45 minutes – 1 hour.
5. Afternoon: 1 hour.

If you find the tasks are taking much longer, please do what you can within the suggested times and do not worry about the extra tasks. I am very pleased with all of your hard work so far.

Our Learning:

Literacy:

In Literacy, we will be writing information sheets on tigers and then we will move on to traditional tales. We will be focussing on the traditional tale the Three Little Pigs, learning the story and then making a change to write our own versions.

Science: Our Science topic this term is 'Treasure Island' we are going to learn how we can survive on our island and learn about the animals that live there and how we can group them.

Maths:

This term we will be beginning by learning multiplication and division, we will then move on to number and place value, counting in jumps of 2, 5 and 10 and reading and writing numbers to 100. Following number, we will study measurement where we will be working on money and finally, addition and subtraction.

RE: In Religious Education we will be learning about the Lord's Prayer, what it means to Christians and why it is important to them.

Our topic this half term is :

Geography: We will be learning about different designs and features of castles from Norman motte and bailey, to modern palaces. We will explore the features of a castle and design a map of our castle.

Art: We will be drawing a castle using 2D shapes, inspired by Paul Klee's Castle and the Sun.

DT:

We will be designing and creating junk model castles using simple construction joins. We will say what we like about our castles and what we might improve.

PE: We will be continuing with our fitness sessions this term.
