Term 3

Maths: In Maths this term we will continue to focus on measurement and geometry where children will concentrate on looking at angles within shapes and coordinates.

Literacy: This term in Literacy we will be studying a range of genres whilst using the Victorians as inspiration. Our first topic will be extended narrative based on Rob Lloyd-Jones' novel 'Wild Boy'. The class will concentrate on a range of grammatical features including noun phrases and using dialogue to convey character.

Science: Our Science topic this term is 'We're Evolving'. The class will be looking at the work of Charles Darwin and learning about evolution and natural selection. The topic includes looking at specific adaptations and how these adaptations help living things survive in their environments.

Religion: Religion this term will be focused around faith and specifically 'Understanding Faith In Westminster'. The class will look at the range of faiths in our school and our local community and will gain an insight into how other religions interact with the local area.

Art: This term we will look at art produced by the artist William Morris.
