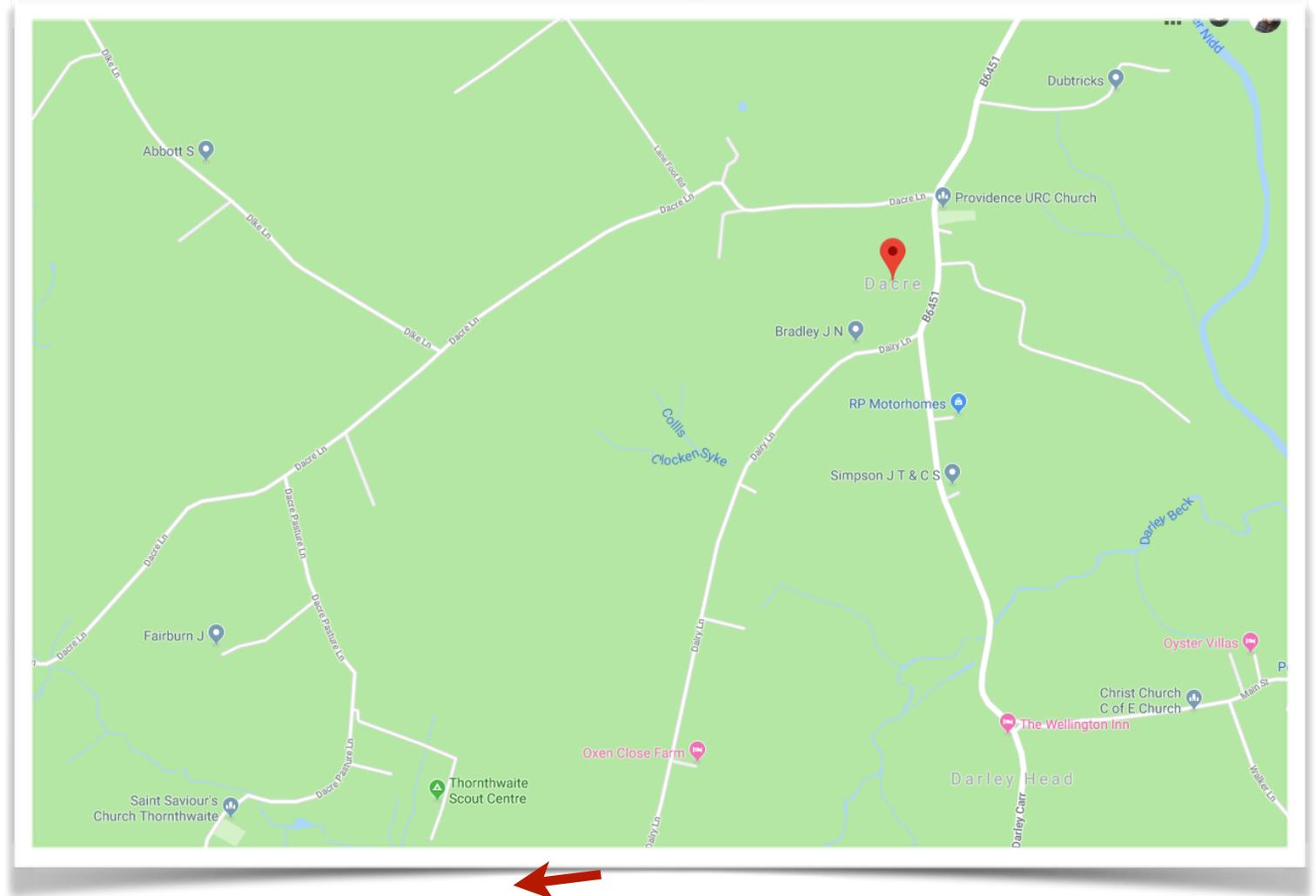
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**Time:** 18:00 Friday 6th March 2020

**Arrival Instructions:** Have dinner before you leave. Arrive promptly **wearing your uniform**, with your gear packed in as few bags as possible. Ideally one bag. **NO BIN LINERS**. You will need to be able to carry your bag to your room. Mobile phone reception almost zero, so do not rely on leaders to guide you in by phone as they will not be able to receive your call.

This is all the standard kit list stuff, but please don't assume you know it all; **there are items on this list that are specific to this event.** Read it and pack the things we ask. Please bear in mind that on the day we leave, your kit may spend some time outdoors while we clean the centre. With this in mind please don't pack any of your stuff in bin bags or plastic bags which are easily torn or opened. **PARENTS - if you are going to pack FOR your scout without their help, make sure they know what they have and why they have it.**

Waterproof Jacket	1	We will be outdoors for most of the day on Saturday do various activities, including walking. We'll do this whatever the weather so be prepared to stay warm and dry. Hiking boots <b>must</b> be waterproof and you should know how to tie them.

Fleece ( <b>A HOODIE WILL NEVER COUNT AS A FLEECE</b> )	2	
Hat and Gloves	1	
Sleeping Bag	1	We're indoors so don't worry about being too cold. Don't bring your sleeping bag in a bin bag.
Pillow	1	
Warm clothes for indoors in case your fleece gets wet	1	A hoodie will work for this bit
Spare Trousers	1	For those unforeseen accidents.
T-Shirts	3	Once they're dirty we don't have a washing machine
Socks	1 pair per day	Or as many as you can manage with (Plus a pair of thick socks to wear with your boots)
Underclothes	1 pair per day	As above (Apart from the thick pair)
Nightwear	1	I'll be packing my Pokemon Go Pyjamas
Washing Kit	1	Including: Soap, Shampoo, Toothbrush, Toothpaste, Towel - we will be washing
Polythene Bags for Wet/Dirty Kit	Loads	To keep your dirty kit separate from your clean kit
Torch	1	It's dark at night and during a lot of the day
Indoor shoes	1 pair	Because your outdoor shoes stay outdoors
Trainers	1 pair	To be used on the traversing wall. These could be the same pair as your indoor shoes if you are packing light.
Water Bottle	1	Resealable leak-free bottle
Small Day Sack	1	Big enough to carry waterproofs and water bottle

**UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES BRING** - Electronic Games; Sweets (you'll get plenty to eat); Mobile phones - there is no reception at Thornthwaite so there is no point; no jeans.
