Order Form

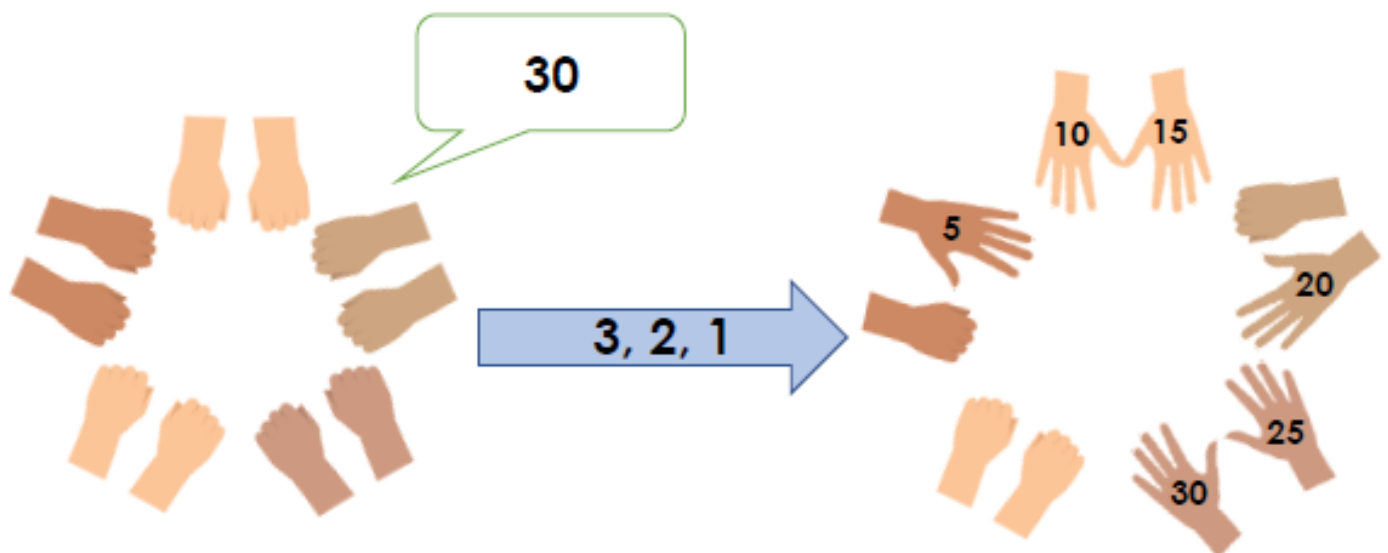
No. of aliens attending	No. of wellies needed

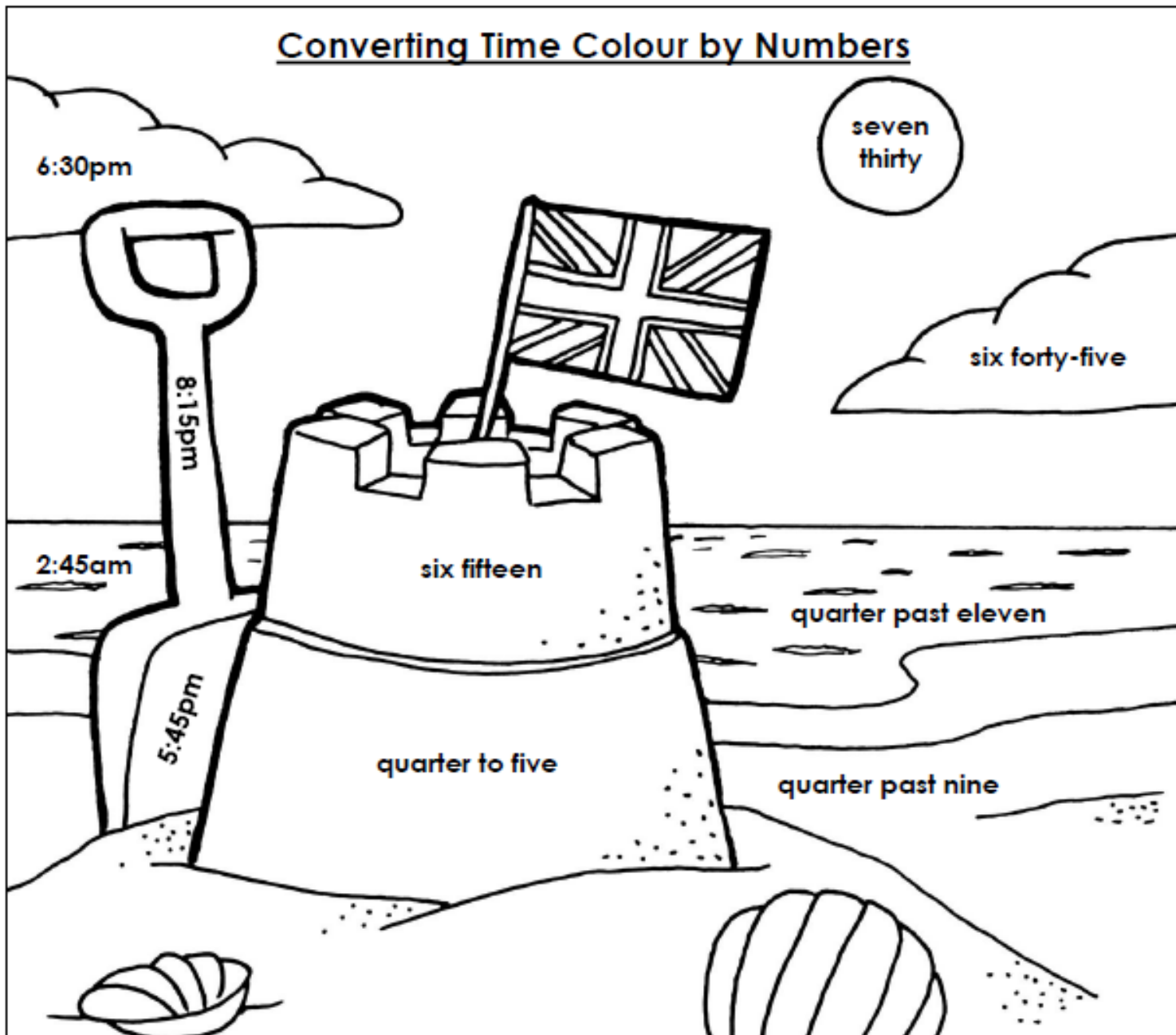
