As a member of *Tiverton Mens HC* you are expected to abide by the following junior club rules:

- All members must play within the rules of Hockey.
- Listen to officials/coaches and respect their decisions.
 - Never argue with an official/coach
 - Never swear or talk back to an official/coach
- All members must respect their opponents and team mates.
- Learn to recognise when someone has played well and tell them so.
- Never put someone down for not playing well or for making a mistake.
- Members should inform the Coach/ Junior Co-ordinator if they are going to be late or will be unable to attend any matches/competitions.
- Always inform the Coach/Junior Co-ordinator at the beginning of a session of any injuries.
- Members must wear suitable kit including mouth and shin guards for training and match sessions, as agreed with the Coach/Junior Co-ordinator.
- Junior members are not allowed to smoke on club premises or whilst representing the club at competitions.
- Junior members are not allowed to consume alcohol or drugs of any kind on the club premises or whilst representing the club.
