RELAXING OF COVID RESTRICTIONS

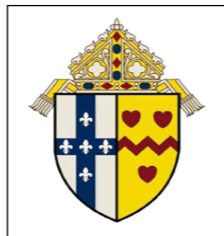
MACMILLAN COFFEE MORNING
