

EGON MÜLLER KANTA RIESLING

Grape Varietals ABV 100% Riesling 13%

Vinification

For the 2010 vintage, Kanta's fruit is sourced from the Echunga Vineyard (>1,300 feet above sea level). After harvest, fruit is cold soaked for 8 hours, prior to natural fermentation with indigenous yeasts. The wine is then held in tank on lees for over 6 months before being bottled. Egon holds the wine back a further 12+ months.

History

Egon Müller is arguably Germany's most highly renowned winemaker, being the fifth generation of his family to produce wines on the famed Scharzhofberg (the only "Great Growth" of the Saar Valley). Egon has teamed up with vineyard and winery owners Shaw and Smith and Adelaide winemaker Steve Pannell to produce this exemplary wine. Kanta is a Sanskrit word meaning the beloved.

Tasting Notes

Very pale colour, with a marked stony aroma and a hint of citrus. Clean and fine-boned on the palate, but with pure and delicate Riesling lemon and mineral flavours.
