



Coppice Primary School Home School Agreement

The purpose of this agreement is to help create a supportive, highly cohesive learning community which works for the benefit of each individual pupil.

As a school we will aim to:

- Provide a safe, nurturing and secure environment in which children can be happy and successful; safe from bullying and racism.
- Provide a variety of teaching and learning experiences, encourage and inspire high standards of work and behaviour.
- Encourage and support pupils to be themselves, be independent learners and make the most of the opportunities that are available to them.
- Give your child equal access to all aspects of school life and support them in achieving their full potential.
- Inform parents about what their children are learning as well as the nature and amount of homework they will receive.
- Communicate regularly with parents regarding children's progress or any concerns. However, as you child's welfare is our first priority there may be occasions where we have to consult other agencies even before we contact you.
- Emphasise the importance of attendance and punctuality and respond promptly and proactively to children's absence.

As a parent/carer I will aim to:

- Ensure that my child attends school regularly, on time and properly equipped and I inform the school of any absence.
- Attend school meetings and parents' evenings
- Support my child with their homework providing an appropriate place to study and encourage the completion and return of homework on time.
- Support the school's policies and guidelines for behaviour, child protection and learning, and their approach to bullying and racism.
- Support the school as a healthy school.
- Keep the school informed about any medical, physical or emotional difficulties my child may be experiencing which may affect my child's work or behaviour.
- Contact the school immediately if I have any concerns.
- Support a safe, secure environment by considerate and safe parking.

As a pupil I will aim to:

- Attend school regularly, on time and bring all equipment needed.
- Wear the correct school uniform and be tidy in appearance.
- Always work hard and do my best with class work and homework
- Follow and promote the school and Trust values
- Ensure that my behaviour is of a high standard.
- Never take part in bullying or racism
- Report any bullying or racist incidents I see to an adult.
- Let an adult know of any worries or concerns I may have.
