Below are the recommended activities to be completed each day of the w.c. 11th May. As always **none of the activities are mandatory**, however they are the sorts of things we would have been doing with the children this week had they been in school, so we have shared these with you to try and ensure that your children don't fall behind in their learning. Highlighted in yellow are the names of any of the resources needed for each activity that are available on Tapestry or the website to download. This timetable is just here as a guideline for how long to spend on each activity, as speaking to lots of parents has suggested that this would be useful, but of course feel free to adapt it to a routine that works best for your family.

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<p style="text-align: center;">Monday (11/05/20)</p>	<p>PE- Joe Wickes/daily walk/ egg and spoon race (ball and spoon race)</p>	<p>Phonics - Tricky word day (so and do) Show children both tricky words on their tricky word mat (they are now on the blue line!), and practice saying them- this can be tricky as they may expect the words to rhyme as they look the same, talk about how this isn't the case.</p> <p>Tricky word hunt around the house- write both words on post it notes and hide them- how many can you find in 5 minutes? PE- Joe Wickes/daily walk
Balancing objects
- have a small teddy bear or cushion and ask your child to balance it on different parts of their body (head, foot, shoulder) can they still balance it whilst walking around the room, or hopping, jogging, skipping.

Phonics- qu
Start with a game of 'fastest finger first'- can your child beat you at pointing to the correct sound on their sound mat? Take it in turns to choose a grapheme to find.

Point at the 'qu' digraph and explain that this is what you will be learning about today? Do they know this sound already?

Read the list of 'qu' words on the worksheet- cut out the pictures and stick them next to the correct words

Quick read- how many of this week's words can you read in 2 minutes? Keep practicing throughout the week to see if you can beat your score

Mindfulness -
Create your own Mindful

breathing wand:

- 1) Take a toilet paper or paper towel roll and cut off the top (about an inch thick) and set aside.
- 2) Cut a straight line all the way up the remainder of the roll.
- 3) Use this cut to tighten the roll to roll it thinner and tape on top and bottom to hold it in place.
- 4) Allow child to decorate the roll with paint, markers, stickers, etc.
- 5) Tape strands of thin light decorative ribbon or streamers along the inside of the small ring you cut off earlier.
- 6) Tape the ring on top of the thinner roll to make the wand.
- 7) BREATHE and notice what you notice.



Topic - our new topic is on 'People who help us'. Have a discussion about who the people are that help us and what they do (police, ambulance, nurse, doctors, teachers, lunchtime supervisors, lolly pop people, fire fighters, dentists, postmen etc) then complete the 'Who Can Help Me' worksheet (the answers are also attached)

PE- Joe Wickes/daily walk/traffic light game - get your child to move around the garden or room in different ways (running, hopping, crawling, rolling, skipping) when you shout red they have to stop, when you shout amber they have to slow down and when you shout green they have to do that action as fast as they can.

Phonics- ch
Start by listening to the blending song:

Cut out the pictures and sort them into 2 groups 'ch sound' and 'no ch sound'. Once you have your 2 groups read the sentences and match each one to one of the 'ch' pictures.
Extension- if you get this finished quickly, there is one 'ch' picture (church) without a sentence- can you write your own?
