Dear Parents/Guardians

We are sorry that it has been a while since we last sent out a newsletter. Since returning from our Christmas break, we have been so busy trying to juggle keeping the setting open in-line with the forever changing government guidance. We really appreciate all of the support that you all give us with our procedures we are having to put in place. We want to start by sending out a gentle reminder that we are now using one door (The main nursery door) for all of our bubbles. As we are all using this door now, please make sure you are wearing your masks and are socially distancing on arrival or collecting your child. It is also important that you respond 'YES' to the daily text declaration.

We also want to remind parents that although we are open, it is still in the guidance to only leave your house if it is essential, therefore please only bring your child to the setting if you feel that it is necessary. If you are not planning on bringing your child, please message us before their session begins as often we could be waiting for children to arrive before starting a focused activity. This brings us on to the next point of arriving on time for your session. It can be disruptive to the other children when their friends are arriving late, especially because we like to start the session with some carpet time. If you are going to be late, please drop us a call or a text message.

Please Name your child's belongings so that they do not get lost!!
