**Ref: Coronavirus Letter**

We hope that you and your family are safe and well.

We have continued to monitor the national and local situation around covid-19 and any possible return to school. I want to update you on the situation and our planning.

It is now clear that years 7, 8 and 9 will not be returning to school until the start of the autumn term. We will continue to set work and support students on-line. We are very grateful for all of the support that you have given to your children with their learning from home.

We are planning to offer year 10 some in-school learning before the summer holiday. We do not yet have a firm start date for this, as we are still waiting for the detailed secondary school guidance from the government.

As we plan any return to school for year 10 these are the principles that we will follow:

- The safety of staff and students is paramount. We will not do anything that puts anyone at risk.
- Any safety guidelines, including social distancing, will be rigorously enforced. This will involve very small classes, of a maximum of nine students.
- We will be very clear and transparent about our plans. Planning documents and risk assessments will be available to parents, if requested.
