


# DAY TO DAY ITINERARY



Date	Activities
Sep 1	<b>DEPART MANILA</b> Depart Manila via PR732 departing at 1920H. Arrive Bangkok Suvarnabhumi Airport at 2150H.
Sep 2	<b>BANGKOK – NAIROBI (L,D)</b> Depart Bangkok via KQ887 departing at 0120H and arriving Nairobi at 0610H. Arrive at Jomo Kenyatta International Airport Nairobi where you will be met after clearing with immigrations formalities and briefed about your safari trip. You are then transferred to Four Points by Sheraton for check in. Lunch will be served. Visit the <b>Giraffe Centre</b> where you get the chance to feed the endangered Rothschild giraffes. Enjoy city tour in Nairobi. <b>Dinner will be served at Carnivore Restaurant.</b> Overnight at <b>Four Points by Sheraton.</b>
Sep 3	<b>LAKE NAKURU NATIONAL PARK (B,L,D)</b> After breakfast, drive to the <b>Great Rift Valley</b> viewing sceneries en-route. <b>Lake Nakuru National Park</b> was once described as the most fabulous bird spectacle in the world and it spans an attractive range of wooded and bush grassland around the lake, offering wide ecological diversity – from the lake waters, woodland to the rocky escarpment and ridges. After lunch, you will have an <b>afternoon game drive</b> which will give you the opportunity to view various wildlife both predatory and plains game, not forgetting the abundance of birdlife. This park also serves as home to both the white and black rhino. Overnight at <b>Lake Nakuru Lodge.</b>
Sep 4	<b>LAKE NAIVASHA</b> Enjoy a last morning game drive in this beautiful park before departing for the <b>Naivasha Country Club</b> arriving for lunch. After lunch, <b>enjoy an hour boat ride.</b> <b>Lake Naivasha</b> is surrounded by stands of papyrus and is birds- watchers paradise. Water birds exist in great variety and abundance. Fish eagle, herons and egrets, lily-trotters, red-knobbed coots and black crakes can be found within the area of this beautiful lake. In addition, to the bird population, over 500 hippos reside in the lake. Overnight at <b>Lake Naivasha Country Club.</b>
Sep 5	<b>MASAI MARA</b> After breakfast drive past the floor of the Great Rift Valley and past Narok to the <b>Masai Mara National Reserve</b> offering wonderful scenery and plenty of game. It is perhaps the only region left in Kenya where the visitor may see animals in the same super-abundance as existed a century ago. Arrive in time for lunch at the camp/ lodge. Late afternoon/evening game drive in this world-renowned reserve, which stretches over 1510 sq km of open rolling grasslands, is watered by the Mara River and littered with an astonishing amount of wildlife. The ultimate attraction is undoubtedly the annual wildebeest migration which happened around July through to October when millions of these ungainly beasts move north from the Serengeti and spread across Masai Mara National Reserve. Overnight at <b>Keekorok Lodge.</b>
Sep 6&7	<b>MASAI MARA</b> Enjoy 2 full days in the <b>Masai Mara</b> with early morning game drives and afternoon game drives. All meals in the lodge. The <b>Mara</b> is also noted for its abundance of lions - particularly the superb black manned males. You'll see lots of elephants here often in large herds, as well as - if you're lucky - leopard, cheetah and rhino. It is home to Africa's famous "big five" (Lion, Elephant, Rhino, Leopard and Buffalo) You're sure to see the African buffalo. Get the cameras ready, stock up on film and enjoy yourselves! Overnight at <b>Keekorok Lodge.</b> You also have an opportunity to go on a spectacular Optional Balloon Ride across the <b>Maasai Mara (\$450 per person).</b> The <b>BALLOON SAFARI ADVENTURE</b> begins in the pre-dawn hours and the magnificent view over the park is thrilling. Towards the end of the flight, you rise to a height of 1500 feet for a panoramic view of the twisting Mara River and the savannah below. After an hour or so in the air, your safari finishes with a flourish: a champagne breakfast in the bush, cooked on the balloon's burners! Please note that this is an optional extra cost not included in the main tour package.



Date	Activities
Sep 8	<b>MASAI MARA - CENTRAL SERENGETI</b> After breakfast, you will be transferred to the airstrip in time to connect your onward flight to the <b>Seronera Airstrip in Serengeti.</b> On arrival, your Tanzania driver guide will meet you for an enroute game drive to the lodge for lunch. <b>Serengeti</b> is undoubtedly the most famous wildlife sanctuary in the world, unequalled for its natural beauty and the greatest concentration of plains game anywhere. This Park is home of the largest concentrations of animals in Tanzania and is the southern extension of the famous Masai Mara Game Reserve of Kenya. It is in this area that annual migration of Wildebeest accompanied by the predators takes place (normally between June and September). Residents Wildebeests always dot the plains. Huge prides of lion live in the Mara; cheetahs are often found on the plains. There are large herds of elephants and buffalo and other plains animals are also to be found. Overnight at <b>Serengeti Sopa Lodge.</b>
Sep 9	<b>NGORONGORO CRATER</b> Breakfast followed by a drive to the <b>Ngorongoro Conservation Area.</b> With picnic lunches, descend to the conservation area and into the crater floor for the afternoon game drives. The <b>Ngorongoro Crater</b> is often called <b>Africa's Eden</b> and the <b>8<sup>th</sup> Natural Wonder of the World,</b> a visit to the crater is a main draw card for tourists coming to Tanzania and a definite world-class attraction. The Ngorongoro Conservation Area (NCA) is home of Ngorongoro Crater. It was formed some 2.5 million years ago from a volcanic mountain sinking due to inactivity, and was initially thought to be higher than Tanzania's famous Kilimanjaro. The crater has evolved into a unique and integral part of Tanzania's eco-system. The crater is actually a caldera, measures 22.5 km's across and the rim walls stand 600m high. Views from within and from the rim are breath-taking (as can be seen from the picture). The crater houses 30,000 animals and a large variety of birds, which rarely move from the area due to the availability of water through wet and dry seasons. Overnight at <b>Ngorongoro Sopa Lodge.</b>
Sep 10	<b>LAKE MANYARA NATIONAL PARK</b> Check-out and proceed to the <b>Lake Manyara National Park</b> for a late morning game drive. You can carry picnic lunches from Manyara Serena or eat an early lunch and proceed to the park. <b>Lake Manyara</b> national park is at the base of the <b>Great Rift Valley</b> escarpment and comprises of forest, woodland, grasslands, and swamps. Gazelles; impala; buffalo; wildebeest; the famous tree climbing lion; hyenas; baboon; giraffe; hippopotamus; and a great number of smaller mammals; 350 species of bird, storks and flamingos Apart from its abundant bird and animal life is known for its tree-climbing lions. Overnight at <b>Lake Manyara Serena Safari Lodge.</b>
Sep 11	<b>LAKE MANYARA – KILIMANJARO AIRPORT</b> After breakfast you will be dropped at Kilimanjaro International Airport for your departure flight via <b>KQ886</b> departing at 1510H arriving Nairobi at 1610H. Your connecting flight will be via <b>KQ886</b> departing 2359H arriving Bangkok at 1330H (12 Sep)
Sep 12	<b>BANGKOK – MANILA</b> Depart Bangkok via PR737 at 1755H arriving Manila at 2225H.
