**GOOD NEWS!** We can now open up our hall for refreshments after Mass on Sundays! There will be tea, coffee, squash and biscuits. All are welcome especially those who are new to our parish.

**ST. MARK'S R.C. SCHOOL - P1 REGISTRATION 2022:** If your child's date of birth is between 1st March 2017 and 28 February 2018 - they are due to start school in Aug 2022. Registration opens on 1<sup>st</sup> November. There will be no Open Day again this year. Registration will be online. Between 1<sup>st</sup> – 19<sup>th</sup> November,
