



## Trafalgar School Uniform Code

At Trafalgar School, we pride ourselves on exceptionally high standards of uniform. We know when students arrive dressed smartly and fully prepared to learn, they feel part of the school community and are more likely to achieve their potential. Full school uniform therefore must be worn at all times.

**UNCRC Article 29:** (goals of education) Education must develop every child's personality, talents and abilities to the full. It must encourage the child's respect for human rights, as well as respect for their parents, their own and other cultures, and the environment.

### School Uniform

- Plain white shirt with traditional collar
- School tie
- School blazer with House Identity Badge
- Trafalgar School Jumper (optional)
- Plain black, straight leg school trousers (skinny fit trousers, jeans, leggings chinos, jean style trousers are not permitted)
- Trafalgar School Skirt
- Plain black or white ankle socks
- Plain black tights (fashion tights are not permitted)
- Plain black, waterproof, fully enclosed shoes (heels no more than 5cm high)\*.

\*Trainers, named casual shoes and 'Dr Marten' style boots are not permitted.

### Appearance

- Hairstyles should be moderate (excessively short hair e.g. Grade one, patterns, tramlines or unnatural hair colours are not permitted)
- One small, plain stud earring may be worn in each **earlobe**, a wristwatch is also permitted but no other jewellery is permitted in school for health and safety reasons
- Additional piercings of any sort are not allowed. Students will be asked to remove these; even in the 'healing stages' they are not permitted
- Spacers are not permitted
- Makeup is not permitted in lower school and should be discreet in upper school; false eyelashes and excessive eyeliner are not considered discreet
- Acrylic, gel nails and nail varnish are not permitted in any year group
- Coats should be weatherproof and plain in design. Hoodies, denim jackets, gilets and tracksuit tops are not permitted in school
- Trainers, sandals and stiletto heels are not permitted
- Hats and caps should not be worn on the school site and outdoor items such as gloves and scarves must be removed in lessons.

Parents should provide a signed and dated note where a non-uniform item is being worn. Even with a note, students will be expected to borrow uniform and may still be sent home to change, or kept out of normal lessons, if they are not in correct uniform.
