

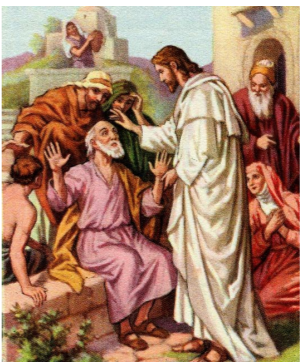

GOSPEL REFLECTION



Jesus cured the deaf man in the Gospel today (Mark 7:31-37) but, thank God, deafness is not a problem for most of us here. Instead our problem may be that we are too busy to hear Jesus. We are so busy making money that we don't have time to enjoy the houses we are so busy working to pay for. We are so busy making money that we don't spend much time at home with our children. Why have children if you are too busy making money to spend time with them? We are so busy that life is slipping by at a very fast rate and we need to slow it down. Where are we all going to end up at the end of life and what is the purpose of life? Life is about getting to know God, loving God and serving God.

Jesus healed the deaf man. If we are too busy we can be deaf to the real meaning and joy of life and deaf also to what the Lord is saying to us. Jesus cannot speak to us if we are not silent enough to listen. I would be very surprised if Jesus were able to communicate with you if you were listening to heavy rock music. But if you were silent I would not be surprised if Jesus communicated with you. We all need silence and space for ourselves and also for God. Jesus said, "when you pray go to your private room and shut yourself in." (Matt 6:6) That private room is
