



2021 APPLICATION PROCEDURE FOR A UIM AQUABIKE SUPERLICENCE

203.02 - ENTRIES - UIM SUPERLICENCE

203.02.01 - SUPERLICENCE CONDITIONS

The World Superlicence or the Continental Superlicence is to be requested 4 weeks before the first event with a photograph.

Superlicence will be issued through the UIM Secretariat only. The pilot must have a valid licence delivered by a National Authority recognized by the UIM and following the UIM activities in Aquabike racing.

The holder of a World or Continental Superlicence cannot be refused by the organizing National Authority except in case of serious fault during the season.

203.02.02 - SUPERLICENCE CRITERIA

- **Four national races or international ordinary races.**
- **Sports CV with official results.**
- **To provide a valid attestation of Civil Responsibility insurance in and out race for a minimum amount of 1.000.000 Euro and with the exception of coverage of the pilots and their Aquabike amongst drivers.**
 1. The attestation of Civil Responsibility insurance will have to be provided written in English or French with the amount of coverage in Euro, no attestation written in another language and/or other currency will be taken into account.
 2. In the event you cannot obtain a Civil Responsibility insurance as per the above rule, please refer to page 4 and 5 of the 2021 UIM Aquabike Superlicence procedure.

SUPERLICENCE FEE

203.02.03 - YEARLY SUPERLICENCE FEE

- World Superlicence 150 Euro
- Continental Superlicence 75 Euro

203.02.04 - DAILY LICENCE FEE

- World Championship 50 Euro
- Continental Championship 25 Euro

The daily Licence is valid for one race only and cannot be deducted when a World or Continental Superlicence is taken.

SUPERLICENCE RIGHTS

The UIM Superlicence gives to the drivers the following rights:

- *To cash the travel proportional money as follows for World Championship events, according to Event Advance Notice:*

The first 10 drivers for RUNABOUT GP1

The first 10 drivers for SKI DIVISION GP1

The first 10 drivers for SKI DIVISION WOMEN GP1

The first 4 drivers for FREESTYLE

- *To cash the proportional travel money for the 3 drivers at Continental Championship (according to Event Advance Notice)*
- *To get a trophy for the first 3 drivers for World and Continental Championships*
- *To get the UIM points if rider is among the 15 first drivers for World and Continental Championships*

ATHLETES CONSENT FORM

As a member of Union Internationale Motonautique (UIM) and/or a participant in an event authorized or recognized by UIM, I hereby declare as follows:

1. I acknowledge that I am bound by, and confirm that I shall comply with all of the provisions of the UIM Anti-Doping Rules (as amended from time to time), the World Anti-Doping Code (the "Code") and the International Standards issued by the World Anti-Doping Agency ("WADA"), as amended from time to time, and published on WADA's website.
2. I acknowledge the authority of UIM and its member National Federations under the UIM Anti-Doping Rules to enforce, to manage results under, and to impose sanctions in accordance with the UIM Anti-Doping Rules.
3. I acknowledge and agree that any dispute arising out of a decision made pursuant to the UIM Anti-Doping Rules, after exhaustion of the process expressly provided for in the UIM Anti-Doping Rules, may be appealed exclusively as provided in Article [13] of the UIM Anti-Doping Rules to an appellate body, which in the case of International-Level Athletes is the Court of Arbitration for Sport (CAS).
4. I acknowledge and agree that the decisions of the appellate body referenced above shall be final and enforceable, and that I will not bring any claim, arbitration, lawsuit or litigation in any other court or tribunal.
5. I understand that:
 - a. my data, such as my name, contact information, birthdate, gender, sport nationality, voluntary medical information, and information derived from my testing sample will be collected and used by UIM and its member National Federations and WADA for anti-doping purposes;
 - b. WADA-accredited laboratories will use the anti-doping administration and management system ("ADAMS") to process my laboratory test results for the sole purpose of anti-doping, but shall only have access to de-identified, key-coded data that will not disclose my identity;
 - c. I may have certain rights in relation to my *Doping Control*-related data under applicable laws and under WADA's International Standard for the Protection of Privacy and Personal Information (ISPPPI), including rights to access, rectification, restriction, opposition and deletion, and remedies with respect to any unlawful processing of my data, and I may also have a right to lodge a complaint with a national regulator responsible for data protection in my country;
 - d. if I object to the processing of my *Doping Control*-related data or withdraw my consent, it still may be necessary for my UIM and its member National Federations and/or WADA to continue to process (including retain) certain parts of my *Doping Control*-related data to fulfill obligations and responsibilities arising under the Code, International Standards or national anti-doping laws notwithstanding my request; including for the purpose of investigations or proceedings related to a

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possible anti-doping rule violations; or to establish, exercise or defend against legal claims involving me, WADA and/or an Anti-Doping Organization.

- e. preventing the processing, including disclosure, of my *Doping Control*-related data may prevent me, WADA or Anti-Doping Organizations from complying with the Code and relevant WADA International Standards, which could have consequences for me, such as an anti-doping rule violation, under the Code;
 - f. to the extent that I have any concerns about the processing of my *Doping Control*-related data I may consult with the UIM and/or WADA (privacy@wada-ama.org), as appropriate.
6. I understand and agree to the possible creation of my profile in ADAMS, which is hosted by WADA on servers based in Canada, and/or any other authorized National Anti-Doping Organization's similar system for the sharing of information, and to the entry of my *Doping Control*, whereabouts, *Therapeutic Use Exemptions*, *Athlete Biological Passport*, and sanction-related data in such systems for the purposes of anti-doping and as described above. I understand that if I am found to have committed an anti-doping rule violation and receive a sanction as a result, that the respective sanctions, my name, sport, *Prohibited Substance or Method*, and/or tribunal decision, may be publically disclosed by UIM and its member National Federations in accordance with the Code. I understand that my information will be retained for the duration as indicated in the ISPPPI.
7. I understand and agree that my information may be shared with competent Anti-Doping Organizations and public authorities as required for anti-doping purposes. I understand and agree that persons or parties receiving my information may be located outside the country where I reside, including in Switzerland and Canada, and that in some other countries data protection and privacy laws may not be equivalent to those in my own country. I understand that these entities may rely on and be subject to national anti-doping laws that override my consent or other applicable laws that may require information to be disclosed to local courts, law enforcement, or other public authorities. I can obtain more information on national anti-doping laws from my International Federation or National Anti-Doping Agency.

UIM - H2O Racing / Civil Responsibility Insurance

2021 AQUABIKE WORLD CHAMPIONSHIP

For the 2021 racing season, H2O racing will again offer to the Aquabike drivers the possibility to take out a **GLOBAL CIVIL RESPONSIBILITY INSURANCE POLICY** which will cover the Aquabike drivers for the **2021 Aquabike Circuit World Championship events only**.

The amount of this insurance cover is **350€ for the 2021 season or 75€ per event, both offers are VALID FOR THE 2021 CIRCUIT WORLD CHAMPIONSHIP ONLY**, to cover the Aquabike drivers holding a **2021 World Aquabike Superlicence** who have not been able to provide a valid proof of insurance cover as requested by the UIM Rulebook, when they applied for the 2021 Aquabike Superlicence.

I. THE 2021 WORLD AQUABIKE SUPERLICENCE (yearly Superlicence)

The UIM will therefore issue two versions of the annual 2021 World Aquabike Superlicence:

- **The 2021 World Aquabike Superlicence:** for the Aquabike driver who is able to provide a valid attestation of Civil Responsibility insurance in and out of race for a minimum amount of 1.000.000 euro and with the exception of coverage of the pilots and their Aquabike amongst drivers (as per rule 203.02.02 of the 2021 Aquabike rulebook).

(The attestation of Civil Responsibility insurance will have to be provided written in English or French with the amount of coverage in Euro, no attestation written in another language and/or other currency will be taken into account)

- **The 2021 World Aquabike Superlicence with insurance:** for the Aquabike driver who cannot provide a valid proof of such insurance cover and who will have to obtain the required insurance cover through UIM/H2O racing. The corresponding amount of **350 €** is payable at the same time as drivers apply for the Superlicence. *(ie. 150€ for the Aquabike Superlicence + 350€ for the insurance = 500€).*

II. THE 2021 WORLD DAILY AQUABIKE SUPERLICENCE (Single event Superlicence)

As per the Aquabike rule 203.02.04, any Aquabike drivers can also apply for an **Aquabike World Daily Superlicence** (50€) to the UIM office until 3 days prior to the event or on-site upon registration.

- Every drivers will also have to provide a valid attestation of Civil Responsibility insurance in and out of race for a minimum amount of 1.000.000,00 euro and with the exception of coverage of the pilots and their Aquabike amongst drivers (as per rule 203.02.02 of the 2021 Aquabike rulebook).

(The attestation of Civil Responsibility insurance will have to be presented to the UIM office or the UIM Commissioner written in English or French with the amount of coverage 1.000.000€ in Euro, no attestation written in other language and/or other currency will be taken into account)

Any driver who cannot provide such insurance cover document upon SL application will be able to take a single event insurance. The amount of **75€ per event/per driver** will have to be paid to the UIM when applying 3 days prior to the event or to the race secretariat when applying for the SL on-site.

UIM NATIONAL AUTHORITY / Civil Responsibility Insurance

2021 AQUABIKE CONTINENTAL CHAMPIONSHIP

For the 2021 Aquabike Continental Championship, the insurance cover **will be provided by the National Authorities hosting the 2021 Aquabike Continental Championship.**

The amount of this insurance cover cannot exceed **90€ per driver/per event.** However, the exact amount will be confirmed in the event's advance notice.

I. THE 2021 CONTINENTAL AQUABIKE SUPERLICENCE

- **The 2021 Continental Aquabike Superlicence:** for the Aquabike driver who is able to provide a valid attestation of Civil Responsibility insurance in and out of race for a minimum amount of 1.000.000 euro and with the exception of coverage of the pilots and their Aquabike amongst drivers (as per rule 203.02.02 of the 2021 Aquabike rulebook).

(The attestation of Civil Responsibility insurance will have to be provided written in English or French with the amount of coverage in Euro, no attestation written in another language and/or other currency will be taken into account)

- **The 2021 Continental Aquabike Superlicence without insurance:** for the Aquabike driver who cannot provide a valid proof of such insurance cover and who will have to take the insurance cover provided by the hosting National Authority on-site when registering to the race Secretariat.

II. THE 2021 WORLD DAILY AQUABIKE SUPERLICENCE (Single event Superlicence)

As per the Aquabike rule 203.02.04, any Aquabike drivers can also apply for an **Aquabike European Daily Superlicence** (25€) to the UIM office until 3 days prior to the event or on-site upon registration.

- Every drivers will also have to provide a valid attestation of Civil Responsibility insurance in and out of race for a minimum amount of 1.000.000,00 euro and with the exception of coverage of the pilots and their Aquabike amongst drivers (as per rule 203.02.02 of the 2021 Aquabike rulebook).

(The attestation of Civil Responsibility insurance will have to be presented to the UIM office or the UIM Commissioner written in English or French with the amount of coverage 1.000.000€ in Euro, no attestation written in other language and/or other currency will be taken into account)

Any driver who cannot provide such insurance cover document upon SL application will be able to take a single event insurance. This specific TBC amount will have to be paid to the race secretariat when applying for the SL on-site.
