Conjunctions

We use:

1. **and:** to join two words or ideas that are similar.
2. **but:** to join opposite ideas.
3. **or:** to give a choice or an option.
4. **because:** to give a reason.

Use and, but, or or because to join these sentences:

1. I ate quickly. I was getting late.
2. Walk fast. You will be late.
3. Sid went to the stadium. He wanted to practice football.
4. My mother went to the neighbourhood market. My mother boughs vegetables.
5. You can go by car. You can go by bus.

7. We went to the park. We played on the swings.
8. Hold your mother's hand. You will get lost in the crowd.
9. I cried. I was hurt.
10. It is hot during the day. It is quite cool at night.
