In Mathematics we will be:

- Recognising, ordering and comparing fractions of shapes and amounts.
- Adding and subtracting fractions.
- Learning the properties of 2D and 3D shapes, drawing 2D shapes and making models of 3D shapes.
- Recognising angles and turns.
- Identifying horizontal, vertical, parallel and perpendicular lines
- Measuring, comparing, adding and subtracting measurements (mass and capacity)
- Solving one and two step problems
- Telling the time on analogue and digital clocks including Roman Numerals to 12.

In The Arts (Music, D&T & Art) we will be:

- Designing, making and evaluating a soup which uses ingredients that would have been available in Roman times
- Studying artists that use weaving and then use this to support our own weaving work
- Developing collage and clay sculpture skills
- Designing and making shelters during Outdoor Week
- Developing understanding of sharps and flats and where they sit in the scale, and learning about major and minor.
- Evaluating and appraising music giving detail and likes and dislikes.
