

Paignton Cricket Club Covid-19 Net Use Policy

This policy will be implemented by the club to ensure the club's net facilities can be safely used during Covid-19 Restrictions, in line with ECB guidelines in 'Using Outdoor facilities in England During Lockdown' and 'Return to Activity in a Cricket Club Setting'. The committee takes responsibility for ensuring conditions of this policy are met, that facilities are maintained and that there is a first aid kit on site.

Bookings - Who

- Can only be made in the name of a member/family who has paid £20 either directly to the club or via the online GoFundMe campaign
- Must be made in the name of someone over 18 years of age. **This adult will be the club's on-site representative and will have the responsibility of ensuring the club's net use policy is followed.**
- Nets may not be used by someone displaying any symptoms of coronavirus
- A list of names who have donated to the club will be kept on the Google drive and updated by NH

Booking – how

- Via the online booking system - <https://teamup.com/ksns3x1d4xkpb2i5v6>
- The booking list will be maintained to enable contact tracing if required

Booking - when

- Will run in hourly slots. Users are expected to finish 5 minutes before changeover to sanitise the net they have just used.

Prior to the net

- Keys to be collected from an authorised keyholder.
- In the event of a first booking, keyholder to email a copy of the net use policy to the person booking.
- Users may not use the facilities if they have symptoms of Coronavirus and they are expected to notify the club if they display symptoms of Covid-19 within one week of using the facilities.
- While there will be hand sanitiser on site, users should carry own if possible.

During the net

- The net will be used in accordance with ECB guidance
- ~~Nets adjacent to each other may not be used~~ (amended – club now using both nets)
- ~~A maximum of 2 people can use the net unless from the same family~~ Now groups of 6.
- Users will wash hands/sanitise before and after their net.
- Users are advised not to touch their faces during the net
- Social distancing will be maintained at all times in line with the 2m guidance
- Users will provide their own equipment where possible. Where equipment is shared, hands must be washed before and after use
- Saliva/sweat must not come into contact with the ball
- No spitting
- Signage will be in place to remind users of safety guidance

After the net

- Nets must be sanitised after use – stumps, padlock, gate and any other areas touched including entrances and exits to the site. **This is the responsibility of the user who has just finished.**
- All property must be collected with nothing left behind
- If a bowling machine has been used it must be cleaned down
- Nets must be vacated promptly with social distancing maintained between groups
- **Keys must be returned directly to the keyholder, not passed on to another member without prior arrangement with a keyholder**
- Nets must be locked and secured upon leaving. If there is an issue locking the net, the keyholder must be advised immediately.
- Keys must be returned to the keyholder on the same day. Members will not be reissued with keys if this condition is not met.

Keyholders

Only the following committee members will have keys: Tim Ward, Tony Medlock, Nick Glanfield, George Benton, Nick Harman, Terry Farkins, Tony Milton

- Keys will be sanitised by the keyholder after each use
- Keyholders must make those who have made a booking aware that no key copies are cut
- Keyholders will lose their right to hold a key if copies are made using their key
- **If additional keys are cut and become more widely available, the net booking system will be terminated.**
- Keyholders and committee members will have carry out spot checks and liaise with users to ensure the rules are complied with.

Members breaking the rules for net use will be warned about their conduct. Failure to follow these protocols will result in the right to use the nets being removed. Further failure to comply will result in termination of membership.

Paignton Covid-19 Ground use Policy

- The ground may be used in accordance with govt social distancing by groups of up to 2 people or more if from the same family.
- Facilities will be closed in the event of a user displaying symptoms of the Covid-19 infection.

Agreed by net committee 20/5/20. To be reviewed at the end of the first day, the end of the first week and thereafter at each committee meeting or sooner in the event of a change in government guidance.
