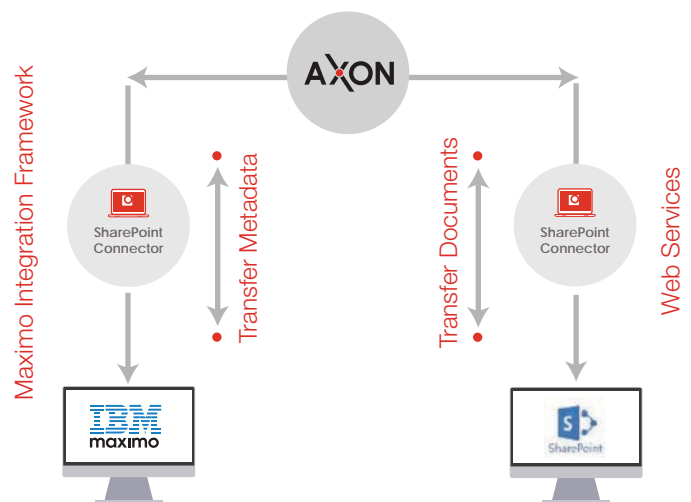
AXON for IBM Maximo & Microsoft SharePoint provides two-way integration between the two applications.
