

### Pupil Premium Spend 2020-2021

Pupil Premium is additional funding provided to schools to support children who are at greater risk of underachievement.

Academic Year 2020/2021

Total number of pupils eligible: 12

Allocation £15,965

All intentions using pupil premium is to accelerate progress to ensure pupils meet at least ARE (Age Related Expectations). The resources purchased through pupil premium is also used to target able children who are eligible for the funding.

How Pupil Premium is spent in 2020/2021

- Small group interventions in reading, maths, writing and phonics
- 1 to 1 provision for targeted groups
- Friendship groups, Circle time Chat and Chill to support confidence and Self Esteem
- Subsidising educational visits and residential
- ELSA
- Extra Curricula Clubs
- Use of external agencies i.e, Behaviour Support, Family Inclusion Services
- Specialist resources support including more able and exceeding.

£15,965 has been spent on the above provision
