



## **TongDuro 2020 COVID – 19 Health & Safety Management Plan.**

**In light of the current Covid-19 epidemic, we at Tongduro recognise the safety & welfare of all who attend as being paramount in our efforts to safely bring you this event. This document communicates the steps we are taking in line with current Government guidelines to protect you throughout the event.**

### **General**

TongDuro is an open-air sporting event across an extensive site area, as such, we believe the Covid demands relating to social distancing can be safely introduced and maintained throughout the weekend.

For all participants, support staff, volunteers, and spectators the following will be introduced:

1. Prior to, or at the point of entry onto the site, **all** individual names, addresses and contact numbers will be taken, these to be held for no more than 21 days and then destroyed. Tongduro staff have the right to refuse entry should individuals not be willing to provide.
2. Temperature checks will be performed on all individuals entering the site, anyone found to be non-compliant with the acceptable temperature will not be allowed onto the site. A 30 min cooling down period will be offered to anyone with a high temperature before a re-test is performed. A max of 3 re-tests are permitted, anyone failing 3 times will not be granted permission onto the site.
3. Hand sanitizer Points will be placed in several locations across the site, including the main entry point.
4. Face masks will be made available for all to purchase (£2), please note we will not be providing face masks as standard free issue, it is the responsibility of the individual in attendance to equip themselves with facemasks if they feel it necessary.

### **Welfare**

1. All Toilets & wash facilities to be disinfected regularly (every 2 hrs) by TongDuro staff over the course of the day with antibacterial spray. Hand sanitizer will be provided and located immediately on entry/exit to the toilet facility.

## **Social Distancing**

1. TongDuro advise that all in attendance, must maintain a safe distance from each other at all times, ie, general movement around the site, rider registration, queuing for racing, food etc... where feasible, groups of friends & families will be kept together in respect of starting positions.
2. We expect all participants and spectators to recognize and respect these wishes to ensure social distancing is maintained, where possible, throughout the weekend.
3. We will endeavor to make regular speaker announcements throughout the day to remind people of social distancing awareness. Please do not be offended if asked to separate within your group if social distancing is not being observed.
4. We encourage all friends and families to, where practical, maintain their respective social bubbles in efforts to minimize interactions. The site has been set out in a way that enables you to do so, and is spread over an expansive area so as to maintain social distancing throughout.

## **Food and Drink**

1. Single use (recyclable) cups, glasses, plates etc will be used throughout this year's event.
2. All Tongduro staff who are responsible for handling food & drink will always be required to wear a mask/viser and disposable gloves (gloves will be constantly changed).
3. Perspex screens will be erected where possible to divide and protect staff and customers.
4. When queuing for food and drink please respect the minimum 1m distancing rules to protect yourself and those others in proximity.

## **Entertainment**

1. During the day and night times of both the Friday and Saturday, various entertainment will be provided to you, we expect all who attend and enjoy this entertainment to respect the social distancing guidelines of not standing in groups of more than 6 people, and when in those groups, please maintain a minimal safe 1m social distance.

The site is extensive, and we will be making all efforts to position seating areas etc across the entertainment areas so as to make social distancing easier to comply with.

## **Camping**

1. The camping area is relatively substantial, and we would request a safe distance of ~3m between each tent/van is respected so as to ensure adequate space for campers to pass when moving around the site.
2. Hand sanitizer stations will be available in and around the camping area.

**Note:** It is advised that anyone showing symptoms of Covid – 19 should not attend this event and any rider will be entitled to their money back should they be confirmed to have the virus prior to 21<sup>st</sup> August.
