



Privacy Policy

We consider the privacy of our visitors to be extremely important. This privacy policy document describes in detail the types of personal information is collected and recorded by this website and how we use it.

1. Competition Shows

Complete entry lists are not published. Certain classes run under drawn order rules and dressage classes will be published on www.poldicevalleyequine.co.uk and our Facebook page showing horse, rider and owner details. Results are available during the show and some events after the show on the website and Facebook pages. This website does not hold the contact details or other personal data about competitors - only their names and results. If you think that your results are incorrect please contact the show (usually via their secretary). Entries submitted via email will be kept for no longer than is necessary for that purpose or those purposes. No information from these records will be passed onto third parties without your consent.

2. Newsletter / Mailing List Consent

By clicking on our submit to mailing list links this will automatically give us your consent to add to mailing list for updates on events, news, competitions and special offers. Should you wish to be removed from our mailing list please email poldicevalleyequine@gmail.com.

3. Log Files

Like many other web sites, we may make use of log files. These files merely log visitors to the site - usually a standard procedure for hosting companies and a part of hosting service's analytics. The information inside the log files includes internet protocol (IP) addresses, browser type, Internet Service Provider (ISP), date/time stamp, referring/exit pages, and possibly the number of clicks. This information is used to analyse trends, administer the site, track user's movement around the site, and gather demographic information. IP addresses, and other such information are not linked to any information that is personally identifiable.

4. Cookies and Web Beacons

We may use cookies to store information about visitors' preferences, to record user-specific information on which pages the site visitor views, and to personalise or customise our web page content based upon visitors' browser type or other information that the visitor sends via their browser.

5. Children's Information

We believe it is important to provide added protection for children online. We encourage parents and guardians to spend time online with their children to observe, participate in and/or monitor and guide their online activity. The only information at we publish about children is their results at our shows - the name of the child and their pony may be published in the results. We will not publish their address, age or other information. Information about their entries is passed direct to the Show Secretary and is not stored on the website. If a parent or guardian believes that we have on this website any personally-identifiable information or images of a child that they feel is inappropriate, please contact us immediately (using the contact details above) and we will use our best efforts to promptly remove such information from our records.



6. Online Privacy Policy Only

This privacy policy applies only to our online activities and is valid for visitors to our website and regarding information shared and/or collected there. This policy does not apply to any information collected offline or via channels other than this website.

7. Consent

By using our website, you hereby consent to our privacy policy and agree to its terms.

8. Data Controller

This policy applies where we are acting as a data controller with respect to the personal data of our website visitors and service users; in other words, where we determine the purposes and means of the processing of that personal data.

9. How we use your personal data

We may process your account data ("account data"). The account data may include your name, address, phone number and email address and any information you send us. The account data may be processed for the purposes of operating our website, providing our services, ensuring the security of our website and services, maintaining back-ups of our databases and communicating with you. The legal basis for this processing is consent.

10. Providing your personal data to others
