

## Dress code - 6<sup>th</sup> Form

At Grace Academy Coventry 6th Form we aim to dress as smartly as we work. It is essential that all 6th form students present themselves in a smart manner.

We are representing the Academy and also setting standards and being role models for those students in lower year groups.

Please find below the expectations for dress when you are a 6th Form student:

### Males

- Tailored trousers - (jeans/tracksuits bottoms are not permitted)
- Blazer or Jacket (optional but hoodies are not permitted)
- Buttoned shirt/Polo shirt/Plain t-shirt (Sportswear or t-shirts with slogans are not permitted)
- Plain black or brown belt if required
- Smart shoes (trainers are not permitted)
- ID Lanyard (this should be around your neck at all times whilst in the Academy )
- Jewellery: plain silver or gold studs (Facial piercings should be discrete)
- Outdoor coats should be smart in style and must be taken off when entering the Academy and kept off throughout the day
- Hats are not permitted indoors at any time

### Females

- Trousers, skirt or business style dress (just above knee length) (ripped jeans/tracksuits bottoms are not permitted)
- Blazer or Jacket (optional but hoodies are not permitted)
- Blouse/ buttoned shirt (this must not be low cut)/Plain t-shirt (Sportswear or t-shirts with slogans are not permitted)
- Smart shoes (trainers are not permitted)
- ID Lanyard (this should be around your neck at all times whilst in the Academy )
- Jewellery: plain silver or gold studs (Facial piercings should be discrete).
- Outdoor coats should be smart in style and must be taken off when entering the Academy and kept off throughout the day
- Hats are not permitted indoors at any time

6th Form staff will ask students to return home to change if we feel that any student's appearance and choice of dress departs from this policy.

The final decision on whether an item of clothing fits within this policy will lie with a member of the 6th form team
