Police Officer and Investigator

November 6, 1981 I successfully graduated as President of the 22nd Session of the Huntsville Police Academy. I worked as a Patrol Officer maintaining civil order, responding to emergencies, protecting people and property, and enforcing motor vehicle and criminal law, generating incident, accident and other appropriate reports.

While working in the Uniform Division one of my duties was as a Warrant Officer. I received misdemeanor and felony warrants, investigated and located the wanted and in many cases apprehended the suspect.

I served as a Training Advisor at the Huntsville Police Academy, training new and veteran officers in a wide variety of subjects. I taught traditional law enforcement subjects and developed specialized lesson plans, to promote greater police knowledge and performance. I trained officers in defensive driving, tactical police driving, firearms, defensive tactics, street survival, interview, interrogation, criminal, traffic and drug laws and most of the other subjects related to the duties of a law enforcement officer. I received a considerable amount of advanced training from agencies around the country as well as valuable information from journals, magazines and interaction with other individuals associated with law enforcement. I gained instructional techniques from various sources which I used to train officers to a higher skill level.

In November, 1987 I was promoted to a Police Investigator and was an Investigator/Undercover Operative with Organized Crime/Vice and Narcotic Unit. At this duty station I received training and worked with DEA, Department of Treasury, United States Attorneys and the FBI which included a Special Deputation for a year. Along with investigation I conducted many different types of surveillance, reconnaissance and other covert operations. Additionally, I performed intelligence operations, counterintelligence and strategic planning of missions. I participated in serving different types of warrants in diverse situations and circumstances. I was involved in personal security, building security, security clearances, and safely escorting people and property. As Investigator I reviewed results of personnel security investigations, summarized unfavorable information and made recommendations. In this role, I ensured that the personnel security regulations, policies, and procedures were considered and adhered to in order to administer the Huntsville Police Department command personnel security program

In May 1994 I transferred to, and spent two years and nine months as a Theft Investigator. I investigated all types of theft cases from the beginning to the final disposition.

A position opened in Internal Affairs February 1997 and I was transferred to the unit. My duties in Internal Affairs were to receive, review, and process requests for investigations. I conducted internal and special investigations for the department and Chief of Police. Some investigations were of a sensitive nature and required tact, discretion and experience to successfully complete the case inquiry. It was important to establish and

maintain effective interpersonal relationships with departmental employees, fellow officers and police management as well as witnesses and others who may have records or other information pertaining to the case. I conducted investigations on all police related shootings, reports of unfavorable information, major traffic accidents, and incidents where any citizen was seriously injured by an officer. I gathered and analyzed information from a variety of sources and made conclusions about its completeness and validity. A detailed report was submitted to the Chief of Police at the conclusion of the investigation. Additionally, I acted on matters of adjudication in personnel security. I accepted complainants on police officers from citizens and investigated the allegations. If warranted I provided adverse information reports to the department and Chief of Police for possible suspension of security clearances, access, and duties. I conducted extensive background checks on police applicants and others as assigned by the Chief of Police.

I honorably retired with 25 years of service on September 6, 2006. During my career I received three Meritorious Service Awards. I am currently certified by the Alabama Peace Officers Standards and Training Commission as a specialized instructor.
