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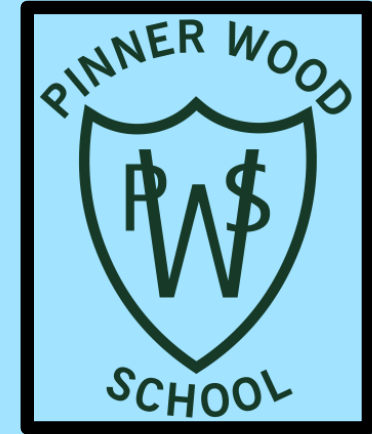

## School Council

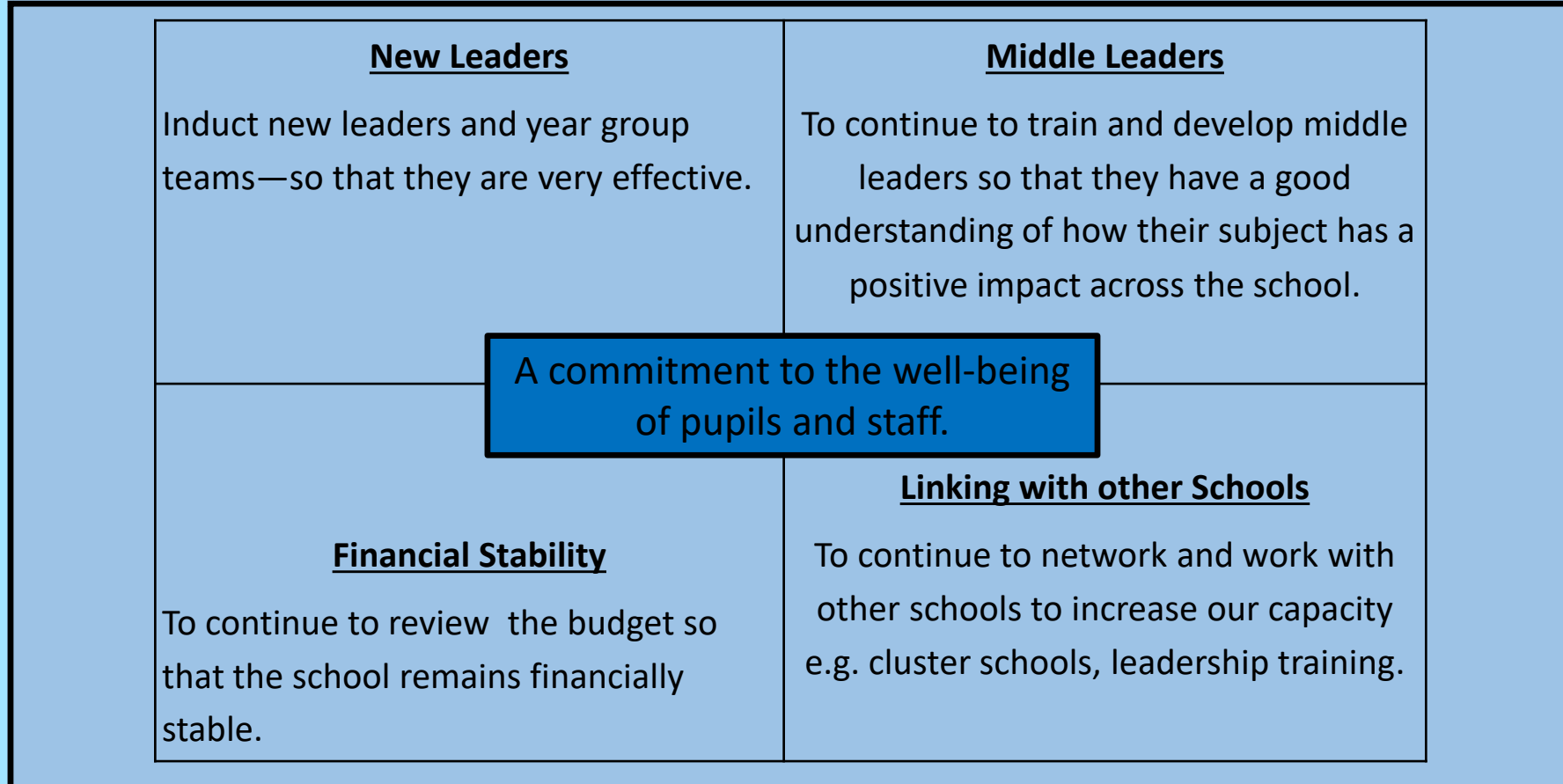
To continue the work of the School Council but ensure they are capturing pupil voice and having a positive impact at their school.
