

# Tawheed

Tawheed is to believe in one Allah. This means that there is no God but Allah alone. It means that we must be obedient to his orders by following his religion, which is Islam.

1. We learn about Tawheed from the **first Kalima**.

**“Laa ilaa ha illal laahu, Mohummadur Rasoolallah.”**

‘There is no god but Allah and Prophet Mohammed (Sallallahu Alayhi wa Sallam) is the Messenger of Allah.’

2. We also learn about Tawheed from **Surah Ikhlas**.

**“Qul huwalaahu ahad. Allah hus samad. Lam yalid wa lam yulad. Wa lam yaqul lahu, kufuwan ahad.”**

‘Say, He is Allah the one and only. Allah, the eternal the absolute. He wasn’t born, nor gave birth. And there is no one like him.

This means that ...

- Allah is one. He is pure, He is unique, and He is free from faults.
- No one is equal to Him, or higher than Him.
- Whatever exists, has NOT always been there, but has been created by Allah.
- Allah has been here forever and will always be here.
- Allah is not a father, brother, son of anyone, nor does he have a wife or any other relations.
- Allah does not need anyone. Everyone needs him.
- Allah does whatever He wills.
- To give life, take life are all under His control.
- Everything Allah does, He does for a reason.
- He is the master of all.
- Allah has power over everything. Nobody can challenge His order.
- Allah knows the past, present and future. Everything that has ever happened and will happen is known to Allah. He is aware of all things.
- His knowledge has no limits.
- Allah says, “I was a hidden treasure and wanted to be known, therefore I created the world.”
- Allah is more loving to his worshipping servants than a person’s parents. Therefore, to worship Allah, we must pray, and live our lives to the Sunnah.

Allah is the only one worthy of worship. This is the message that all Prophets were sent to deliver. Prophet Mohammed (Sallallahu Alayhi wa Sallam) is the last Prophet to be sent to us – to guide us in how to show belief in the oneness of Allah.
