

1. Imaan

- Translation of **Imaan-e-Mujmal**. 'I solemnly declare my belief in Allah as He is with all His names and attributes, and I have accepted (to obey) all His commandments by pledging with my tongue and testifying them with my heart.'

IMAAN is simply to **believe** in your heart in all that Almighty Allah has asked you to believe in, then it is to **say** it with your tongue, and then it is to do the **actions** to back up this belief.

Strong Imaan

- Is someone who firmly believes in the 7 beliefs and backs up this belief by actions e.g. 5 pillars of Islam. To understand this, we can compare this to a tree which has strong roots and is fully blossomed.

Weak Imaan

- Is someone who believes in the 7 beliefs, but may not do the actions to back up this belief. For example, a tree which has strong roots, but is bare – no flowers.
- Every time you commit a sin, your Imaan gets weaker.
