

5. Messengers/Prophets

- Almighty Allah has sent down many prophets. Ultimately only Allah (Subhana Watala) knows the true number.
- All Prophets are special servants of Allah (Subhana Watala) who have been sent to guide people to the right path.
- They taught people to do good deeds and stay away from evil deeds.
- No one can become a Prophet – this is a gift to certain people by Almighty Allah.
- Muslims believe in all the prophets but do not worship them. We only worship Almighty Allah.
- All prophets had one key message – to tell the people all about Tawheed. The Prophet Mohammed (Sallallahu Alayhi Wasalam) had **two key** messages – Tawheed and Islam.
- 25 prophets are mentioned by name in the Quran.
- The chief of all the Prophets is our Beloved Prophet Mohammed (Sallallahu Alayhi Wasalam).
- Prophets are blessed with the most excellent of qualities like truthfulness, intelligence, trustworthiness, beauty and wisdom.
- The Prophets of Allah (Subhana Watala) are all human beings.
- The one who rejects even one Prophet of Allah (Subhana Watala) is not a believer.

Some of the Prophets sent into this world by Allah (Subhana Watala) are:

- Prophet Adam (Alayhis Salaam) – The first prophet to be sent into this world.
- Prophet Nuh (Alayhis Salaam)
- Prophet Ibrahim (Alayhis Salaam)
- Prophet Musa (Alayhis Salaam)
- Prophet Isa (Alayhis Salaam)
- Prophet Mohammed (Sallallahu Alayhi Wasalam) – The last Messenger sent into this world.
