

6. Day of Judgement

- All Muslims must believe in the Day of Judgment
- Only Almighty Allah knows exactly when the day of judgement will happen.
- On the Day of Judgement, everyone will be brought back to life.
- On this day, we will appear before Almighty Allah to answer for all of our actions.
- The first question we will be asked about on the day of judgement will be about Salaah (namaz).
- No one will recognise each other, everyone will be filled with fear.
- Many different things will happen on this day.
- Everyone's deeds (good and bad) will be weighed on a scale called the Meezan.
- We will all have to cross a bridge (the Pul-Sirat) that is thinner than one strand of hair and sharper than a sword. Below the bridge is the fires of Jahannam. Some people will cross the bridge like lightning. This will depend on their worldly actions.
- Those who committed good deeds during their lives will be rewarded with Jannah (Paradise) by the mercy of Allah (Subhana Watala).
- Those who committed bad deeds during their lives will be rewarded with Jahannam (Hell) by the justice of Allah (Subhana Watala).
- Whoever lived their lives as good Muslims will have no fear on that day. They will be treated with respect.
- Our Prophet Muhammad (Sallallahu Alyahi Wasalam) will help his followers by interceding for them with Allah (Subhana Watala), and asking Allah (Subhana Watala) to forgive them.
