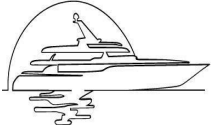


SUMMARY OF COVID 19 PROTOCOLS - 12 October 2021

GENERAL

- Grenada is open to **fully vaccinated** foreign nationals. Those arriving by sea OR by air, are treated as 'fully vaccinated' either;
 - **2 weeks after the date of their second dose (of any vaccine involving 2 doses); OR**
 - **2 weeks after the date of their single dose (for vaccines involving only a single dose);**
- **Accepted vaccines** - Moderna; Pfizer; Janssen (Johnson & Johnson); Astrazeneca; Covidshield; BBIBP - CorV (Vero cells); Coronavac and Sputnik.
- Exemptions to the 'fully vaccinated to enter rule' do exist but these are limited to citizens & residents of Grenada (holders of permanent residency status, those with work permits, diplomats or those working for the Government). If a foreign national should come within this category they are not required to be fully vaccinated to enter Grenada.
- Foreign nationals arriving in Grenada **MUST** present a Negative PCR test upon entry. The PCR test must be obtained within 72 hours of departure for Grenada. (IE. The tests must be no older than 72 hours at the point of travel.)
- Vaccination cards are also to be presented upon entry to officials to confirm a person's official vaccination status.
- Persons must **complete a further PCR test upon arrival in Grenada.** **For air arrivals, this test must be paid for in advance and online via the Government's payment portal - <https://pay.gov.gd/>.** Each traveller shall pay **USD \$50 per PCR test.** (Those arriving by sea are not required to pay in advance.)
- Each person **arriving by air** must also present the Pure Grenada Travel Authorisation Certificate. This is to be applied for online and not earlier than 7 days before travel to Grenada. To apply for the Pure Grenada Travel Certificate please use this link <https://covid19.gov.gd/vaccinated-travellers/> or <https://travelauth.health.gov.gd/>. Persons must print the travel certificate **and** also have an electronic copy to show to officials.
- **BEFORE applying for the travel certificate persons must;**
 - **pay for the entry PCR test and obtain the payment receipt information required to apply for the travel certificate;**
 - **book shoreside quarantine accommodation to obtain the booking reference (minimum 2 nights) also required to obtain the travel authorisation certificate.**
 - **In the case of wanting to go directly to the vessel for quarantine, please contact us.**
- Please be aware not all content on the government's website has been updated. The summary here accurately reflects the current protocols.

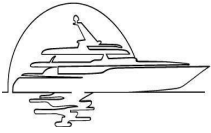

QUARANTINE PERIOD FOR ARRIVING PERSONS

- Quarantine period is up to 48 hours.
- No person can leave quarantine until authorised by Health Officials.
- Persons shall be released from quarantine once the Grenada PCR test result is returned as negative (between 24 - 48 hours).
- Persons arriving by air must also arrive with a printed copy of the travel authorisation certificate. This certificate represents the official permission required to travel to Grenada.
- To obtain the travel authorisation certificate - see above.

QUARANTINE FOR TRAVELLERS WITH CHILDREN

- **U12's & unvaccinated** - the same quarantine as vaccinated parents (48 hours);
- **Over 12's & unvaccinated** - the whole family or travelling party shall have to quarantine for 7 days. Provide PCR tests on Day 5 and await test results usually available within 48 hours of the Day 5 test. 7 days accommodation is required to be booked.
- **Over 12's & vaccinated** - shall perform the same quarantine as their vaccinated parents (up to 48 hours).

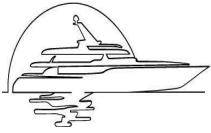
BOOKING ACCOMMODATION (ALL)

- **Fully vaccinated persons / booking accommodation** - those arriving by air who are fully vaccinated will be required to make a confirmed booking in an approved shore based accommodation for a minimum of 2 days.
- Those arriving with children must make either a 2 day booking or a 7 day booking depending on the age of their children - please see above.
- A booking confirmation code is required to be entered when applying for the Pure Grenada Travel Certificate. So make the accommodation booking before you apply for the travel certificate.

ARRIVALS BY SEA

Those arriving by sea shall be assessed first by health officials who will tell them the first available date for PCR testing, which is normally every weekday at 1400. **(NB. Arrivals by sea do NOT need to apply for the Pure Safe Travel Certificate** as that certificate relates only to persons quarantining on shore. Nor do they need to apply for their days at sea to count towards quarantine - this is automatic).

- Super yacht guests arriving by air do not have to quarantine IF the vessel is ready to clear out; however this must be on the same date as their arrival by air.
- Super yacht guests can perform quarantine aboard their vessel in the quarantine anchorage or on the dock at Port Louis Marina - an application is required to be made by a Ship's Agent for quarantining on the vessel
- Grenada has a private jet protocol and 'safe corridor' to and from the vessel. Guests do not need to complete any quarantine IF the vessel leaves Grenada on the same date as the guest arrival by air **OR** if the guests arrive by sea and depart Grenada by airplane on the same date.

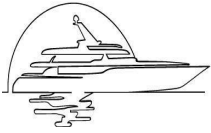


- Grenadian businesses are open; island tours, restaurants, bars, resorts are serving holiday makers.
- **PCR & Antigen testing is available on island at both private and public facilities – results are available within 48 hours, by email, for those wanting them for onward travel to other islands.**
- No CARICOM EXEMPTIONS - all inter-island travel between CARICOM nations requires a negative PCR test result, obtained within 72 hours prior to travel (children 5 & under are exempt).

GRENADA'S AIR ENTRY PROTOCOLS

A. TRAVELLING BY AIR – PRE-ARRIVAL PROCEDURES

1. Obtain a **Pure Safe Travel Certificate**
 - a. Apply for the certificate online - <https://travelauth.health.gov.gd/> or <https://covid19.gov.gd/vaccinated-travellers/>
 - b. Do this once quarantine accommodation and entry PCR test have been booked and paid for.
 - c. It is only possible to apply for the Travel Certificate within the 7 days before arrival. I.e, you cannot apply for the certificate more than 7 days before arrival, but it must be done no later than 48 hours before travel
 - d. Each traveller must obtain a Pure Safe Travel Certificate, including minors.
 - e. **Each traveller must carry a printed AND electronic copy of the Certificate** so they can present it upon check-in / prior to boarding the flight or vessel to Grenada and upon entry to Grenada.
2. **ALL travellers** arriving to Grenada will also be required to pay a **one-time \$135.00 XCD (\$50.00 USD)** for the PCR test that will be administered at Grenada's airport. Payments can only be made online via the Government's payment portal - <https://pay.gov.gd/>. **Once paid, persons shall receive a payment receipt which has a reference number that must be cited in order to commence the application for the air travel certificate. So make this payment first before starting the air travel certificate application process.**
3. **A Negative PCR test must be obtained from a certified laboratory within 72 hours of travel, i.e. within the 72 hours prior to departure for Grenada.** Each traveller aged 6 or over requires a PCR test.
4. All persons entering Grenada by air shall also be required to book 2 nights quarantine accommodation. Proof of this booking is also required before applying for the travel certificate. **Do not start the travel certificate application until you have this.**
5. **Persons who are NOT fully vaccinated, or eligible for a vaccination exemption, shall be denied entry to Grenada.**



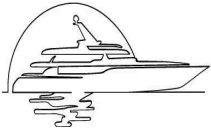
6. Obtain travel insurance for each traveller that covers COVID-19 related illnesses.
7. Download the relevant contact tracing app and register PRIOR to travel. As the app is not presently available for iPhone users, they are currently exempt from this requirement.
8. **Yachts can be considered as 'Approved Accommodation'; travellers (guests & crew) can apply to complete quarantine onboard. Please note there is no automatic right to this. An application must be made by your agent to the Ministry of Health. Each application shall be determined on a case by case basis. If you would like us to do this please note we require 4 days to submit the application - so we must receive your instructions and information at least 4 days prior to your arrival. The application must include boat papers, travel itinerary for each person and a copy of each person's passport biodata page. Please submit these to us by email - superyachtservicesgrenada@gmail.com.**

B. TRAVELLING BY AIR - PROCEDURES AT AIRPORT & BEYOND

1. Upon arrival to Maurice Bishop International Airport - Grenada, all travelers must;
 - a. Complete health screening (symptom review, temperature checks, and testing if necessary);
 - b. Present their Pure Safe Travel Certificate, negative PCR test and proof of full vaccination to Health Screeners for verification;
 - c. Proceed to Immigration and Customs for inbound processing;
 - d. Take the pre-approved transportation to the approved accommodation (Hotel or Yacht) and commence the quarantine period. The date quarantine starts is treated as **Day Zero. Arriving passengers will not be permitted to leave quarantine until medical clearance is granted.** This will be confirmed within 48 hours of the testing and once the test results are known to be negative.
2. Travellers in quarantine are NOT allowed any visitors prior to receiving health clearance to exit the approved accommodation.
3. If the Traveller's PCR test is POSITIVE she/he will be required to remain in quarantine at a designated facility. (This may be your existing quarantine facility or you may be transferred to an isolation or treatment facility as determined by Grenada Health Officials).

C. COVID-19 TEST FEE - US \$50.00 / EC \$ 135.00

ALL travellers arriving to Grenada will also be required to pay a **one-time \$135.00 XCD (\$50.00 USD)** for the PCR test that will be administered at Grenada's airport / sea port. Payments can only be made online via the Government's payment portal - <https://pay.gov.gd/>. **Once paid, persons shall receive a payment receipt which has a reference number that must be cited in order to commence the application for the air travel certificate. So make this payment first before starting the air travel certificate application process.**



D. PRIVATE JET PROTOCOL AND 'SAFE CORRIDOR' FOR CHARTER GUESTS

Grenada has a private jet protocol and 'safe corridor' for charter guests going to/ from the airport and vessel. Guests do NOT need to complete any quarantine if:

- a. Guests arrive BY AIR, and on the SAME DAY, proceed directly to the vessel and depart Grenada.
- b. Guests arrive BY SEA, and on the SAME DAY, proceed directly to the airport and depart Grenada by private plane.

E. GUESTS ARRIVE BY AIR AND DEPART BY SEA ON THE SAME DAY

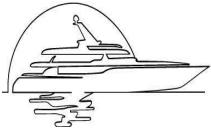
NO SHORE QUARANTINE IS REQUIRED. Guests who fly into Grenada can move directly to their vessel and depart the same day WITHOUT having to perform quarantine on shore. **Please note the following:**

- a. Submit an application via your Agent, at least 4 days prior to the guest's arrival;
- b. Prior to any guest arriving aboard, all crew must have received health clearance by Ministry of Health (either having arrived by sea and done quarantine aboard OR having arrived by air and done quarantining in approved accommodation) and be aboard prior to the guests' arrival;
- c. **Guests must then follow the protocol for arrival between airport and vessel and the returning journey, vessel to airport. These are detailed separately and available upon request.**

F. TRAVELLING BY PRIVATE JET - PROCEDURE PRIOR TO TRAVEL

Private flights are allowed to land at the Maurice Bishop International Airport. Each flight request shall be considered on a case by case basis following the process below;

- a. Submit flight plan to obtain pre-approval to land. The application is to be submitted to the Civil Aviation Authority AND the Ministry of Health's Chief Medical Officer.
- b. Please have the Pilot send the flight handling request to GNDOPS@IAMJECENTRE.COM In the handling request please include ETA & ETD and crew and passenger manifests. The IAM Team will bring your flight request before the Ministry of Civil Aviation / Health officials. They will act as liaison between these decision makers and will work closely with them to ensure your flight has the best chance of being approved.
- c. Flight origin and travel history of passengers & crew will be key factors in determining whether the flight is granted approval to land.
- d. FBO / GROUND HANDLER - The FBO we recommend using is the IAM Jet Centre by Signature.
- e. ALL passengers & crew, no matter their origin, are required to present a NEGATIVE COVID-19 test upon entry. **All PCR tests must be obtained within 72 hours of departure for Grenada. (They can be no older than 72 hours at the point of travel.)**

G. TRAVELLING BY SEA – PRE-ARRIVAL PROCEDURES

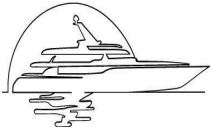
1. Follow steps 2-3 detailed above under **TRAVELLING BY AIR - PRE ARRIVAL PROCEDURES**. NB. **The Pure Grenada Travel Certificate is not required for those arriving by sea as their information is registered via Sailclear.com**
2. Register with Sail Clear - <https://sailclear.com> - at least 24 hours prior to arrival OR we will be happy to register on SailClear for you. (NB. Grenada Lima is no longer operational.)
3. Complete all forms including the Maritime Declaration Form. Print a copy of each form to present also to Health Officials upon arrival to Grenada. If we are registering on SailClear for you, we will email you this form.

H. SEA ENTRY PROCEDURES - UPON ARRIVAL

1. Yacht must go directly to the quarantine anchorage. If your yacht is 200 gross tons, or above, you will need a pilot, from Grenada Ports Authority, to put you on anchor. We will arrange this for you. OR we can apply for your vessel to quarantine on Port Louis Marina's dock.
2. Each person aboard MUST physically check in with Ministry of Health Officials at the Grenada Yacht Club – you must dinghy here from the main vessel. OR, we can arrange for Health to come aboard your vessel if you have asked us to apply for permission for the yacht to quarantine on Port Louis Marina's dock
3. Each person MUST present their outbound Clearance from their last port, Maritime Declaration Form, negative PCR test and proof of full vaccination to Health Screeners for verification. Their travel history will also be requested / considered.
4. Complete health screening (symptom review, temperature checks, and further testing IF deemed necessary). **NB. Health screening is not offered around the clock. Screening ONLY operates Monday - Friday 0800 - 1600 AND Saturday, Sunday and Public Holidays - 0900 - 1400**
5. Throughout the screening process, all persons must adhere to COVID protocols (mask wearing, remain social distant, sanitise)

I. SEA ENTRY CLEAR IN AND QUARANTINE PROCEDURES

1. Quarantine must be completed aboard in the quarantine anchorage. For superyachts they can apply to quarantine aboard the vessel on the dock at Port Louis Marina. An application is required, which we can complete upon your instruction.
2. At the end of the quarantine period (24 - 48 hours), and receipt of the PCR results, once the PCR test is negative, Health Officials will issue a card to permit shore clearance.



3. Once the vessel has been issued with this card or 'health clearance', the vessel is then ready and able to perform inbound clearance with Customs & Immigration. Present the health clearance card, along with all passports and original outbound Clearance from your last port, to Customs & Immigration. ***If you want us to perform this for you we will be happy to do so.*** Just let us know.

J. GUESTS ARRIVE BY SEA AND DEPART BY AIR ON THE SAME DAY

NO QUARANTINE IS REQUIRED. Guests who arrive in Grenada by sea can move directly from the vessel to their private jet and depart the same day WITHOUT having to perform quarantine. **Applications are to be made on a case by case basis through your agent.**

- a. Submit an application to the Ministry of Health (**via your Agent**) at least 4 days prior to the guest's arrival.
- b. Submit an application to Port Louis Marina (**via your agent**) to obtain **pre-authorisation to use their quarantine dock for a short stay (for guests to disembark)**. The charge for the short stay is US\$20. Additional charges may apply if the boat remains on the dock for more than 4 hours.
- c. Submit an application to Immigration and Customs (**via your agent**) to **obtain pre-authorisation for inbound clearance (in principle)**. This has to be done at least 2 working days in advance of when you plan to arrive.
