

Summary of the CURRENT COVID19 Regulations for arriving to St. Kitts and Nevis: October 2021 (Subject to change)

Arriving by Sea

- All persons arriving into the Federation of St.Kitts & Nevis must be fully vaccinated.
- All arrivals must submit COVID 19 RT-PCR negative test result from a CLIA/CDC/UKAS approved lab accredited with ISO/IEC 17025 standard, taken prior to 72 hours of travel, or within 72 hours departure from previous port.
- Negative Tests results, Vaccination Card & Passport data pages must be uploaded and completed on the online form: <https://www.knatravelform.kn/> .

Our team at St.Kitts Yacht Services can facilitate this process on behalf of the vessel.

IMPORTANT: We must receive your approval letter before you can enter into the Federation of St.Kitts & Nevis

- There is a mandatory Quarantine for 24 hours upon arrival. For vessels over 80 feet, they will be required to quarantine inside of Christophe Harbour Marina.

Transit time between your last Port of call and The Federation of St. Kitts & Nevis will apply to your Quarantine period of 24 hours.

Upon arrival a RT PCR test is mandatory for all crew & guests.

Upon receipt of a negative RT PCR test, travelers will be able to fully integrate into the Federation. (Children who are unable to be vaccinated, who are travelling with fully vaccinated adults will be approved, following the same regulations as noted above).

- COVID 19 RT-PCR Test will be administered on board the vessel for each crew/passenger within the quarantine period. Cost: US \$150.00 per person. (Depending on time of arrival, RT-PCR swab will be completed on arrival, and allow 24 hours for results to be returned).

Customs and Immigration Clearance will be managed in tandem with all health protocols.

Customs: Sail Clear will have to be filed on behalf of the vessel.

Immigration: Eapis will have to be filed on behalf of the vessel.

Upon arrival, a representative of St.Kitts Yacht Services, will collect all passports to complete the immigration and customs clearance and finalize all arrival health protocol requirements.

Arriving By Air

Crew Arrivals

All protocols as previously mentioned will need to be followed. It is highly recommended that the arriving crew be housed in one of the Hotels that provide a "Vacation in Place" stay during the quarantine period. If the crew member were to join the vessel upon arrival, the entire vessel will be placed back into a 24 hour Quarantine.

Guest Arrival

St. Kitts has a private jet terminal known as Kayan Jet, www.kayanjet.com .

Prior to guest arrival, all the above-mentioned protocols will have to be followed. Upon arrival the Guest(s) will be transferred to the vessel in a pre-approved vehicle. Once the guests have boarded the vessel, the vessel and all crew on board will be placed back into a 24 hour Quarantine.

The vessel then has the option to depart The Federation of St.Kitts & Nevis without completing the 24 hour Quarantine period. The vessel may remain in Quarantine inside of Christophe Harbour for the 24 hours then fully integrate into St. Kitts & Nevis.
