Overcoming the digital divide

The Lifeline program provides a monthly discount for low-income subscribers. The discount is \$9.25 per month for subscribers of Internet (with or without telephone) or \$7.25 per month for customers with telephone only. Subscribers are also exempt from paying the Federal Universal Service Charge (FUSC).
