A few years ago, we launched the Leadership College for young adults. We knew it was our job to do everything we could to **ensure a better future for our youth**. It was not enough to say, "God has a plan for your life", and "You can achieve your dreams", without giving them the **resources** and **support** to be **successful**. For some, this has been the very first place they have felt safe and secure enough to call home.

### A Place For Everyone

What we did not know was the **tremendous impact our Leadership College students would have on our community**. They have inspired hundreds of middle and high schoolers, with similar stories to their own, to want more for their lives. They have risen to the mantle of leadership and become Service Technicians, Jr Project Managers, Event Planners, Youth Pastors and more.

We began the Leadership College with young men, but not long ago, we began accepting young women. While they could participate in the training and gain experience, we were unable to offer safe housing as we do for our young men. **This year, as we accept our next incoming class, we are seeing that we must make safe housing available to our young women as well.**
