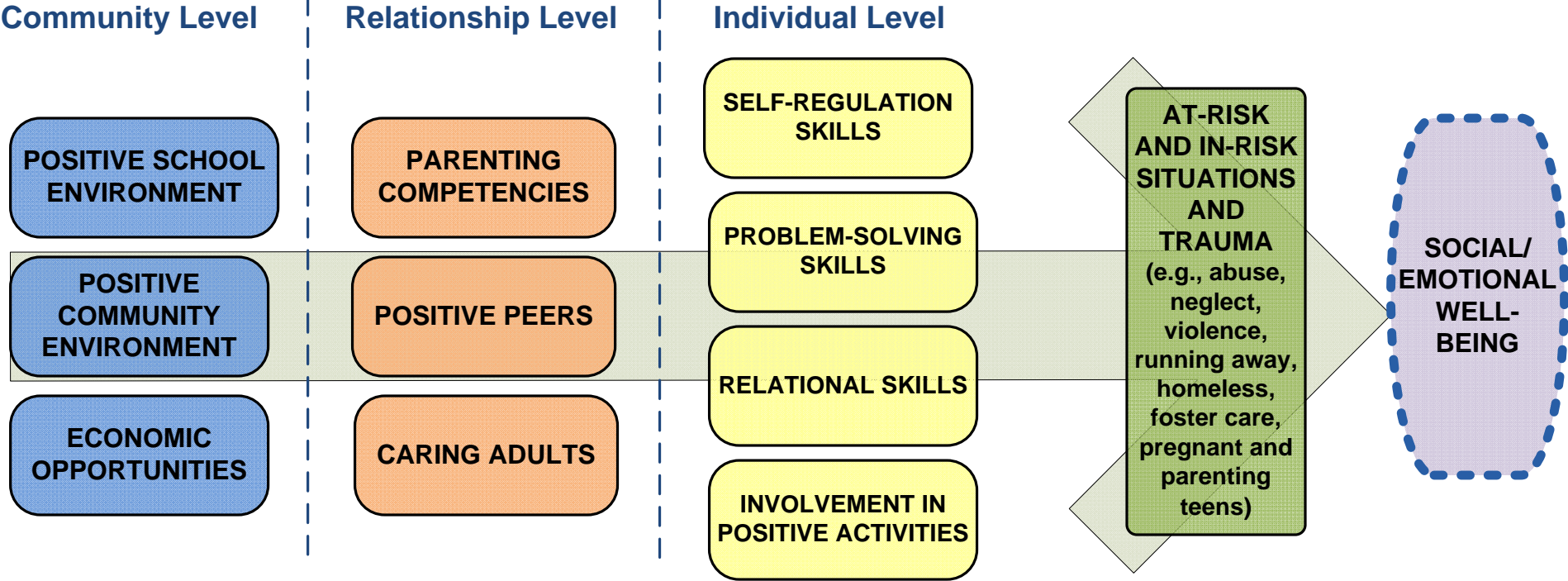

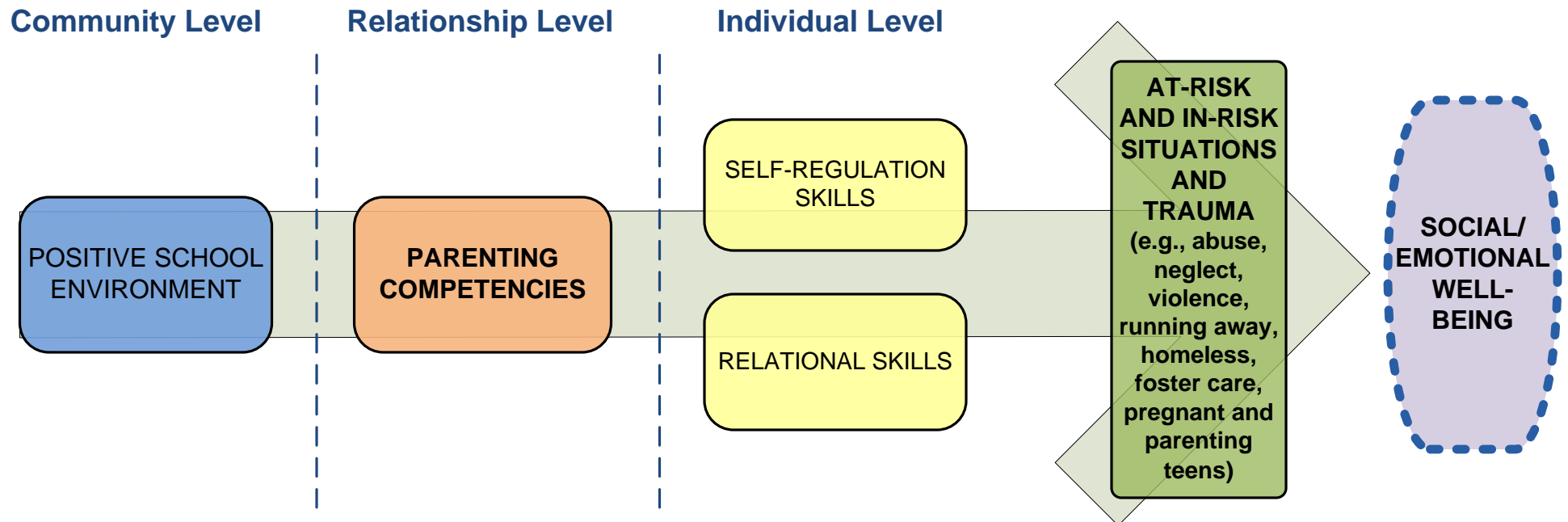

Draft Protective Factor Model for Youth Exposed to Domestic or Community Violence

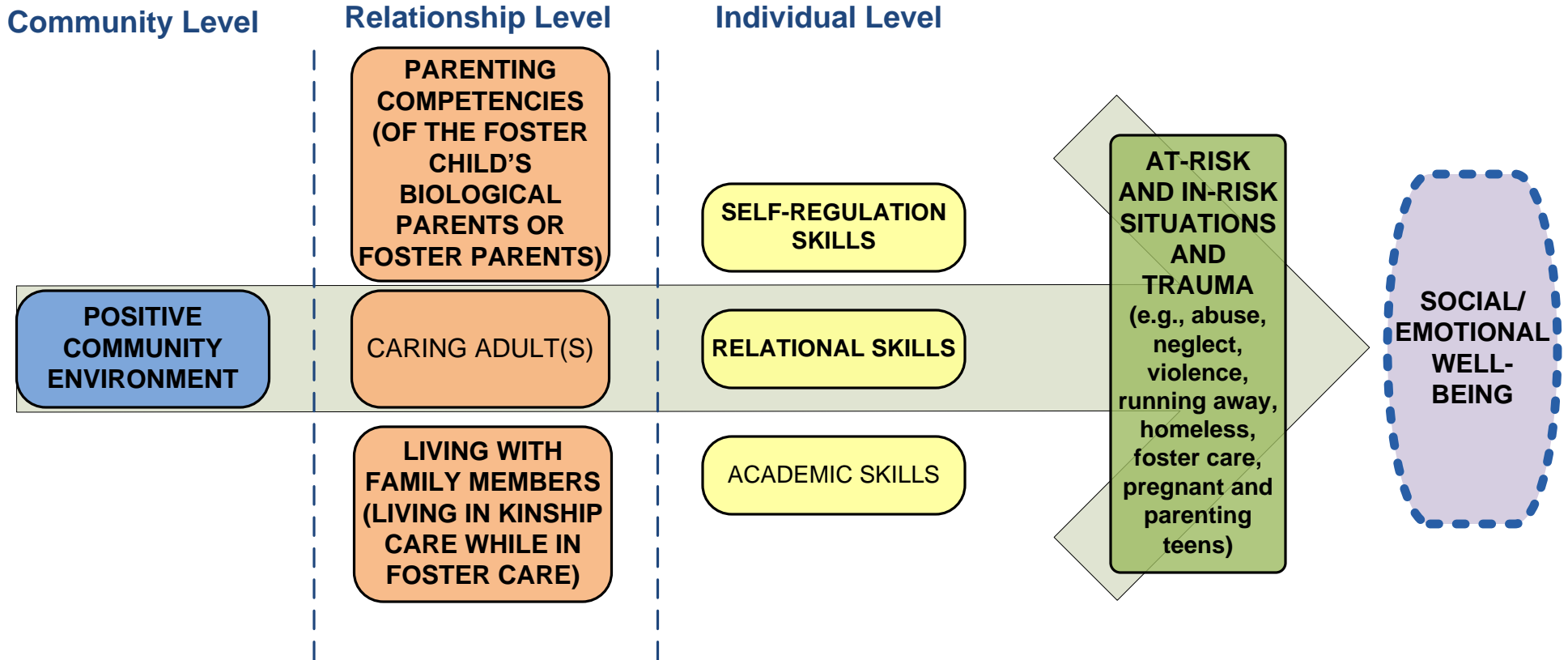

Draft Protective Factor Model for Youth in or Transitioning Out of Foster Care

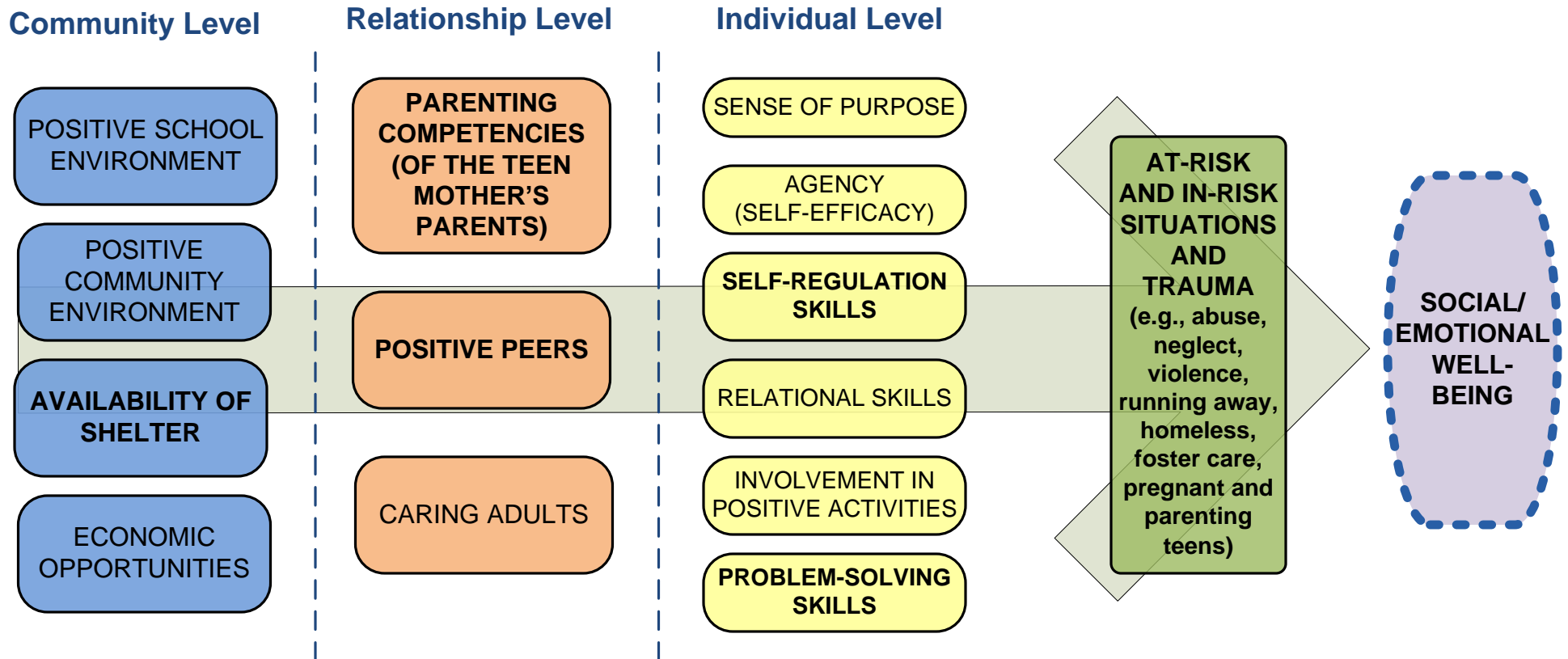

Draft Protective Factor Model for Child Abuse and Neglect

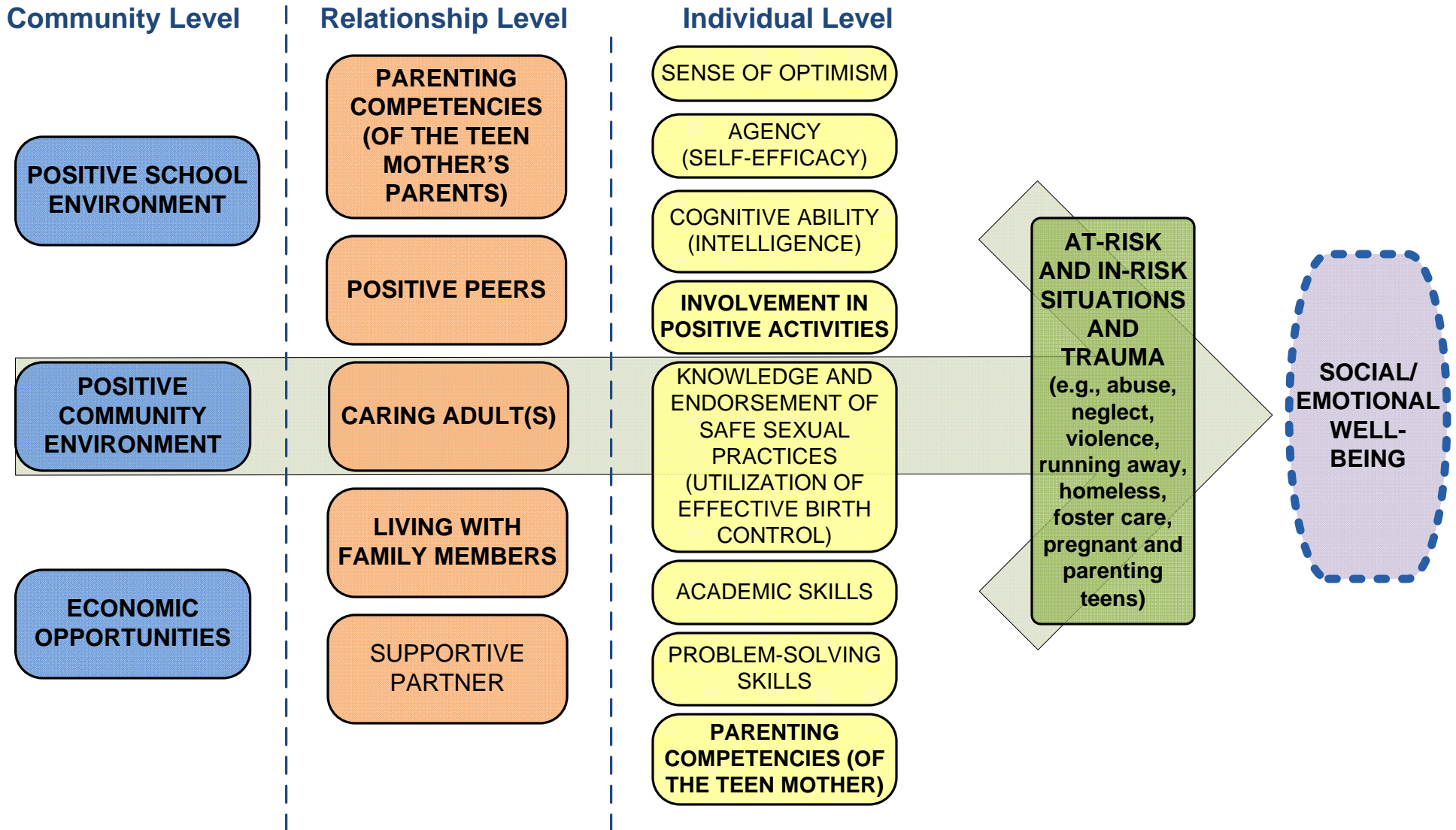
