Ordinance No. 2007-01

FIRE DEPARTMENT REIMBURSEMENT

Section 1: PURPOSE

This ordinance permits the Township of Alcona Fire Department to charge a fee to utility companies for guarding downed power lines and transformer emergencies.

Section 2: CHARGES

The following charges shall hereafter be due and payable to the Township of Alcona from a recipient of the following services from the Fire Department:

- A. Guarding downed electrical lines, for each site guarded. \$350.00 initial cost plus \$35.00 per hour for each additional hour lines are guarded.

Section 3: TIME FOR PAYMENT

All the foregoing charges shall be due and payable within thirty (30) days from the date the service is rendered. Default of payment shall be collectible through proceedings in the District Court or in any other court of competent jurisdiction as a matured debt.

Section 4: EXEMPTIONS

The following properties and services shall be exempt from the foregoing charges:

- A. False alarms.
- B. Fires involving Township buildings, grounds, and/or property.
- C. Fire service performed outside the Township under a mutual aid contract with an adjoining municipality.

The provisions of this Ordinance shall take effect 30 days after being published in the Alcona County Review.

This Ordinance passed by unanimous vote of the Alcona Township Board at the regular meeting on December 11, 2007.
