## ONLINE MEMBER SECURITY

Our member's online safety and security is important to us at PTCCU. As of January 2021, PTCCU is introducing MFA (Multi-Factor Authentication). MFA allows members to recover usernames and reset passwords for Online Banking without the need to call or visit the branch. Members only have to click "recover username" and then indicate how they would like to receive a passcode (text, email, or call). When entered into Online Banking, the passcode confirms the members identity and allows them to perform their transactions.

It is important that PTCCU maintains updated contact information for each member to ensure uninterrupted accessibility to online banking services.

Please make sure the PTCCU has your most up-to-date phone number, cell phone number and e-mail address on file.

### User Name Requirements

Must Contain:

- At least 5 characters
- At least 1 number and 1 letter

Cannot Contain:

- Space, less-than (<) or apostrophe(')
- Your account number(s)

### Password Requirements

Must Contain:

- At least 8 and at most 30 characters
- At least 1 number and 1 letter
- 1 uppercase and 1 lowercase letter

Cannot Contain:

- Space, less-than (<) or apostrophe(')
- Your account number(s)

Some members will already meet the requirements, but many will need to update their username and/or password. If updates are necessary, select Settings at the top of the screen. From here, you can update your Password, Username, E-mail Address and Contact Information.
