The past month was a busy one for the grounds staff. With the paving finished, we have begun to fill the cart path edges and seed them. To date we are finished with the range and #3. With some cooler temps and hopefully a little rain we will finish the last two paths in the coming weeks and get those areas grown in. With that being said, these areas we are seeding need to be left untouched by carts for the rest of the year. The young plants cannot hold up to repeated wear from carts.

And like I have seen a few times already, the newly sprouted seed cannot withstand any cart traffic. Please do your best to stay on the paths!!!!!! Lastly, if you play the blue tees, you need to stay on the cart path and not park up at the blue tee. The turnaround area by the white tee is where golf carts should be parked for blue tee players.

We will begin tee aerification tentatively on October 10th. This will cause little to no disruption to play. The date for fairway aerification is still up in the air. We need some rain showers and cooler temps before we can move forward. The earliest we would begin the fairways would be the 23rd of this month.
