#### ACCEPTABLE FOR LADIES

SLACKS - Golfing Slacks / Regular Slacks / Nylon Warm-up Suits  
SKIRTS - Jamaican lengths  
SHORTS - Bermuda (knee length walking shorts)

TOPS - Collared shirts / High Rounded neck tops / Sleeveless tops with collars  
SHOES - Must be worn

#### UNACCEPTABLE FOR ALL MEMBERS AND GUESTS

blue jeans / cargo pants / hip huggers / sweat pants / short shorts / blue jean shorts / gym shorts / jogging shorts/ sweat shorts / tennis shorts  
halter tops / tank tops / T-shirts (white, colored, or printed)  
bare feet / stocking feet/ shower thongs

Please note.....shoes must be worn at all times. Bare feet, stocking feet, or shower thongs are prohibited. Participants not conforming to the Club dress code will not be permitted in the Clubhouse, nor on the golf course.
