Havurah (חבורה) The word *havurah* comes from the Hebrew word “*haver*”, meaning friend. At Temple Etz Rimon our *havurot* are small circles of friends who share similar interests and values.

The size of Havurot may vary, but the intent is to create a smaller group (which will have closer connections) within our larger congregation. Each Havurah may choose to be focus on one area or interest (for example, social, Jewish study, or even literature study and enjoyment) or some combination of activities. Regardless of the purpose, a Havurah will be a group of people who enjoy spending time together and learning from each other.
