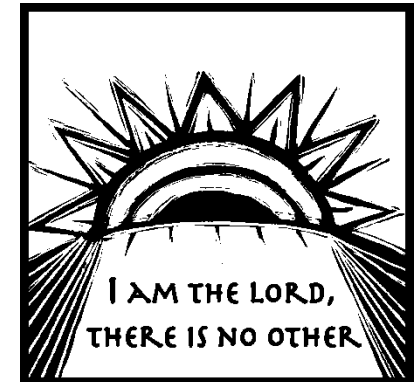

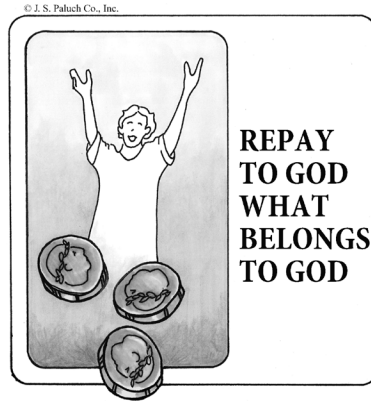
The Profession of Faith:
