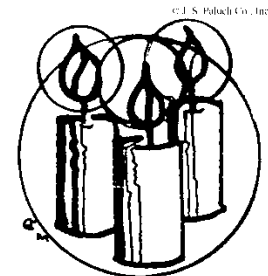

The Profession of Faith:

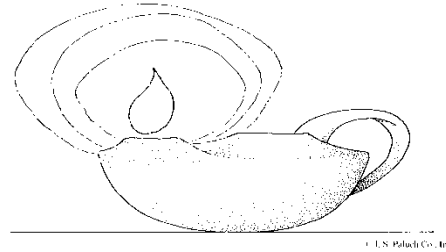
I believe in one God,
