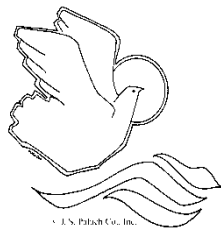

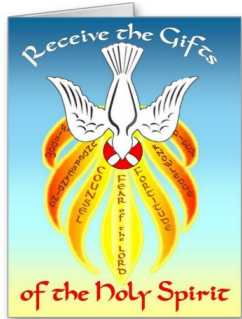


Our annual Parish Meeting will take place on January 17th at 9:40 a.m. in the social hall. Guidelines for mask wearing and social distancing will be followed.

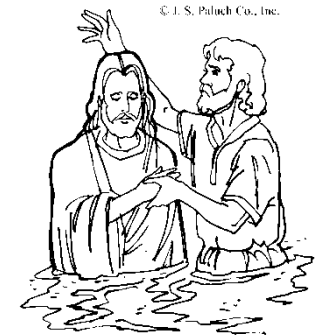
