

In-Person and Virtual Mile Swim - December 5th

Dear Swimming Friends and Family! Leah Mossor Tunstall and I have run our swim team, Piedmont Aquatic Club (PAC), for almost 30 years now, and the last 20 of those years have been at the wonderful Armfield Civic Center in Pilot Mountain, NC. Sadly, due to aging equipment and COVID-19 budget uncertainties, the community indoor pool where we have essentially raised our four daughters is in danger of closing.

On Saturday, December 5th, 2020, Leah and I are hosting an in-person and virtual mile swim to raise funds to contribute to the Stay in the Swim campaign at the Armfield Center to save the pool.

The in-person 1650 yard swim will have 1 heat every 90 minutes beginning at 7:00 AM with 8 swimmers per heat and a 75-minute maximum race time (to allow for clearing the deck and cleaning between heats). Heats will run from 7:00 AM to 7:00 PM. Details regarding COVID-19 safety precautions will be emailed to registered participants.

Virtual participants can swim at home any time after registering below and results should be sent to swim4pac@gmail.com (1650 short course yards or 1500 short/long course meters). Times are due by 8:00 PM ET on December 5th.

Awards will be given to the top 3 finishers in each of the following categories:

- PAC Alumni
- WVU Alumni
- BPHS Alumni
- 18&UN swimmers by USA Swimming age groups and gender
- Swimmers not in the above categories (Masters, Lap Swimmers, etc.) by gender

The entry fee is \$50 and all proceeds go toward saving the pool.
