In addition to founding the Order of Dominicans (priests/nuns), the spread of praying the rosary is attributed to St. Dominic. Thanks to the Ehlers family for the beautiful floral bouquet to mark this special feast.

Your Donations at Work

Parish Centre Kitchen

Renovation work in the Parish Centre Kitchen began last week. The project is being financed by your donations to the One Heart One Soul campaign initiated at St. Dominic in 2018. Upgrading the kitchen was one of the major parish projects for which the campaign solicited funds. Like so many other things, execution of this project was delayed many months due to the pandemic.

Throughout the kitchen, vestibule and refreshment areas the original VCT flooring is being replaced with Altro Classic 25 safety flooring to provide lasting slip resistance and durability. The installation includes a flash cove base up the wall, welded and capped with stainless steel edging.

Stainless counters with integrated triple and double sinks will replace the original formica countertops. The countertop adjacent to the dishwasher will be extended. The project also includes several minor cabinet modifications to increase workflow efficiency. Lastly a new electric double oven will replace the original appliances.

Project completion and reopening of the kitchen is targeted for the week following Labour Day.
