Regular trustee's meeting/June 18, 2019

Cooper called the meeting to order at 7:30 P.M. The minutes were corrected. Joe moved and Tad seconded the motion to approve the minutes. The vote was unanimous in favor.

Warrants #10692-10721 in the amount of \$177,026.25 were presented for approval and payment. Terry moved and Tad seconded the motion to pay the warrants. The vote was unanimous in favor.
