

AGREEMENT WITH JOHNSON COUNTY ANIMAL COVERAGE FUND

This agreement is made this _____ day of _____, 20__ between the Johnson County Coverage Fund and _____ of _____, Wyoming.

The coverage fund agrees to:

1. Cover the listed animal or animals, which are owned and are being carried as junior livestock market animals in Johnson County Wyoming.
2. Pay the owner the amount stated in the terms of this agreement in case of death of the covered animal(s).
3. Any death loss will be paid September 15th of the 4-H year. In any case, coverage will terminate on killed date or September 1st of the year; whichever comes last.
4. If more animals die than the Animal Coverage Fund can cover, then each member who had a loss will be paid in proportion to the extent of the fund. (Example: If the fund had \$1000.00 and five (5) calves died, then each member would receive \$200.00)
5. Eligible animals: Market calves, market lambs, market hogs, market goats, market rabbits, and market poultry.
6. The Johnson County Livestock Committee and/or buyers of livestock at the Johnson County Junior Livestock Sale will not be responsible for any animal before, during or after the annual livestock sale.

The owner agrees to:

1. Pay into the fund a specified amount as a donation upon the date of this agreement.
2. Notify the county educator or the 4-H club leader immediately upon death of an animal. Death must be verified by the county educator, and one 4-H club leader, or by two 4-H leaders. If there is a question of cause of death, then a veterinarian will be called in to verify.

Terms of Agreement:

1. Cost of this coverage is payable on date of the agreement and will cost:

• Market Beef	\$50.00
• Market Lambs	\$20.00
• Market Hogs	\$20.00
• Market Goats	\$20.00
• Market Poultry	\$ 2.00
• Market Rabbits	\$ 2.00
2. The covered value of the animal will increase periodically as per the schedules attached as Appendix #1.
3. Payment on dead animals will be paid on the month value of the month death occurred, regardless of the date of death.
4. This agreement does not cover death directly or indirectly caused by:
 - a. Any malicious or willful injury
 - b. Carelessness
 - c. Neglect
 - d. Purposely inflicting death unless first consulting the county educator program or 4-H leader.

5. No animal claim will be paid on animals dying with seven (7) days of the applicant's receipt in the Johnson County Extension Office. This waiting period is implemented so that insurance may be purchased anytime yet prevents the purchase of insurance in face of imminent loss. Members are encouraged to purchase insurance upon ownership of their animal or by first pay out month for specific species. However, if State Fair tags are not available; the Johnson County Extension Office will provide a tag, member must use that tag and provide a photo of animal with such tag in place.

6. This insurance is administered by the Johnson County Livestock Committee, a committee composed of all Livestock Leaders currently enrolled in the County Extension Office and the FFA advisors. Any claims disputes will be settled by this committee.
