**WHEREAS**, after these items are no longer on the Defense Logistics Agency inventory, the Sheriff's Department can dispose of said items; and,

**WHEREAS**, a D7 Caterpillar Bulldozer is one item that was procured through this program by the Sheriff's Department; and,

**WHEREAS**, this bulldozer is no longer on the Defense Logistics Agency inventory; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Sheriff's Department has the authorization to transfer this piece of equipment; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Mora County Road Department is in need of such equipment, to carry out the day-to-day duties of the department; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Sheriff's Department does hereby intend to transfer this D7 Caterpillar Bulldozer, Serial Number W91NBN41070011A, to the Mora County Road Department;
