- Write down questions you have from your Sunday School class then explore the answers Sunday afternoon. Come back to Sunday School next week with any further questions or answers to share.
- If you haven't done so yet, give your life to Jesus. The words don't matter, it is what is in your heart. Pray, admitting you need Jesus, trust His death on the cross to make it possible, tell Jesus He is now in charge of your life from this day forward and thank Him for coming in. LOOK AT YOU GO! - Hide God's word in your heart. Start with memorizing this verse.
Romans 3:23 *"Everyone has sinned. No one measures up to God's glory."*
- Keep scripture close to your heart:
Joshua 24:15 (b) *"as for me and my family, we will serve the Lord."*
- Start your small group Journey with Monday night or Wednesday night, in addition to Sunday School program .
- Start looking at what it means not just to attend, but become part of the church.
- Once we decide to follow Jesus, we need to learn the path to discipleship. The Journey is an intentional plan for discipleship that provides a purposeful process for maturing in Christ.
