

Obey Maturing

- If God has given you maturity, you have been commissioned by Jesus to share that maturity by teaching others what you do know.
 - See Pastor Julie about a small group you may lead or other ideas she may have
 - If you are already doing this, start mentoring someone to follow you and do their own small group or class
- Consider being a mentor for someone else that needs help obeying Jesus. Are you someone's person? Who can you walk alongside to help like your person helps you?
- Where are you called to reach out into the community, partnering with God and the community to be a blessing to others?
- Talk to the pastors about how your gifting and experience lead to another area where God is calling you to lead in the church
 - A ministry team
 - A service ministry
 - A hole you see in what the church can do
- Consider the importance of small groups and pray about the necessary education to become a leader of a small group.
- Talk to April regarding a testimony on the importance of obeying Jesus and keeping His word embedded in your heart.
- Scripture says where your money is is where your heart is also.
 - Where are you on tithing from all your increase?
 - Where are you on giving beyond the tithe?
- Are you attending a Sunday or Wednesday morning Bible Study? If you are, try keeping a journal of the life applications each week. Return to them frequently to determine if you are living into the life applications. If you are not attending, choose one and try it consistently for a month or two.
- Read and ponder this article. It has some difficult concepts. We invite you to talk to the pastors with any questions you have.
